PAC-12 NOTES

PREVIEWING THE WEEK: PREVIEWING THE WEEK: Pac-12 baseball conference play kicks off this week with six games broadcast on Pac-12 Networks. Entering league games, four teams are ranked in the top 20, including reigning NCAA Champion Oregon State taking over the No. 1 spot, while No. 19 Arizona State is one of just two undefeated teams remaining in the country.

A marquee three-game series between No. 1 OSU and No. 3 UCLA in Los Angeles highlights the week, with Saturday and Sunday's games broadcast on Pac-12 Networks. It will be a battle between two of the best pitching staffs in the country. The Bruins boast the best ERA in the nation at 1.91, second-most shutouts (five), fourth-best WHIP (0.95) and is third in hits allowed per nine innings (5.76). Meanwhile, the Beavers rank eighth in ERA (2.30), seventh in WHIP (1.01) and fourth in hits allowed per nine innings (5.78).

Another three-game Conference tilt to watch is Washington vs. Oregon. The Ducks have shown their strengths in the field and on the base paths this year, as they boast the best fielding percentage in the league and ninth-best in the nation (0.984), as well as the most stolen bases in the Pac-12 with 30. The Huskies also have a speedy weapon on its squad in **Braiden Ward**, who has the most stolen bases in the Conference (12). Ward and his teammate, right-handed pitcher **Josh Burgmann**, swept the Pac-12 weekly awards, and Burgmann is currently tied for the league lead with 31 strikeouts on the year.

WEEKLY RECAP: With Conference games ahead, the Pac-12 boasts a 104-51-1 (.670) non-conference record. Arizona State is one of just two teams still undefeated in the nation. After going 4-0 against CS Fullerton and Xavier last week, ASU's 15-0 start is the program's longest winning streak (and longest streak to start the season) since it went 24-0 to start the 2010 campaign.

Also last week, Stanford controlled the series over No. 18 Texas, winning three of four games and outscoring the Longhorns 21-3 in all three victories. USC notched a 4-1 upset victory over No. 25 Michigan during the Dodger Classic, as NCBWA Stopper of the Year candidate **Connor Lunn** tossed a perfect four final innings, stranding two inherited runners and striking out three along the way.

IN THE RANKINGS: Four Pac-12 teams are ranked in the latest USA Today Coaches Poll, including three in the top five. Oregon State claimed the top spot at No. 1, UCLA is No. 3 and Stanford is No. 4. Undefeated Arizona State moves up to No. 19. Also receiving votes are Oregon and Washington. The Bruins, Beavers and Cardinal rank in the top-8 in all five national rankings.

Seven of 11 Pac-12 programs rank in the top 75 in RPI rankings. Oregon tops the RPI list, with Oregon State close behind in third, and Stanford and ASU ranking fifth and sixth, respectively.

BY THE NUMBERS: Pac-12 pitchers have dominated on the mound as four teams rank in the top 10 in ERA. UCLA has the best ERA in the nation at 1.79. Arizona State's pitching staff has an ERA of 2.10, which is good for fourth-best. Oregon State is eighth-best at 2.30 and Stanford comes in at ninth with a 2.31 ERA.

The Pac-12's top hitters own three of the top-five best on-base percentages in the nation. Cal's reigning Golden Spikes Award winner **Andrew Vaughn** ranks second with a .603 average. *Collegiate Baseball's* Projected Player of the Year, OSU's **Adley Rutschman** is third at .600 and Oregon's standout first baseman **Gabe Matthews** is right behind in fourth (0.594). Matthews also has the best batting average in the Pac-12, hitting .469.

STAR POWER: The Wildcats infielder **Cameron Cannon** leads all NCAA Division I baseball players with 11 doubles in just 16 games this year. Twice this year he has slugged multiple doubles in a game and has at least one double in 8-of-16 games. He also ranks second in the Conference in batting average (.439), runs scored (23) and is tied for most hits at 29 with teammate **Matt Frazier**.

ASU's **Hunter Bishop** has been an important piece in maintaining the Sun Devils' perfect record, earning himself his first-career Pac-12 Player of the Week honor. The junior homered once in each game over Xavier to extend his season total to eight, the most in the league and fourth-most in the country. In the 11-6 series finale victory over the Musketeers, Bishop matched his career-high with five RBIs.

Stanford's southpaw **Erik Miller** also picked up his first-career Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week award after getting his second win of the season by setting a career high with 101 pitches, tying a career high in strikeouts (9) and season high in innings pitched (6) while surrendering just one hit in a 9-0 win over No. 18 Texas.

PRESEASON NODS: The Pac-12 has 20 total preseason All-America selections from seven different schools. Six student-athletes were named to all five preseason All-America lists and 2018 Golden Spikes Award winner Cal's **Andrew Vaughn**, 2018 CWS Most Outstanding Player OSU's **Adley Rutschman** and All-Pac-12 selection UCLA's **Chase Strumpf** were named to the first team by five national outlets. Rutschman was also tabbed the Projected Player of the Year by *Collegiate Baseball*. *Baseball America* highlighted several league student-athletes as All-American Best Tools with Vaughn earning best hitter, Arizona State's **Spencer Torkelson** selected as the best power hitter and Rutschman tabbed as the best defensive catcher.

GOLDEN SPIKES: The Pac-12 is home to eight Golden Spikes Award winners after **Andrew Vaughn** claimed the award last season, tying the ACC and SEC for most of any conference. This year, ten student-athletes from seven different league schools were named to the preseason Watch List, including Vaughn. He is just one of four Golden Spikes Award recipients all-time to return to school after winning the award. Oregon State, UCLA and Stanford each boast a pair of student-athletes on the prestigious list. The preseason watch list features 55 of the nation's top amateur players. The 42nd Golden Spikes Award will be presented on June 14, 2019.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK - Hunter Bishop, Jr., Arizona State

Arizona State outfielder Hunter Bishop nabs Pac-12 Baseball Player of the Week honors after posting a monstrous week in leading the Sun Devils to a 4-0 record in a win on the road against Cal State Fullerton and a home sweep of Xavier, helping the Sun Devils remain one of just two unbeaten teams in the country. The junior homered once in each game over Xavier to extend his season total to eight, the most in the league and fourth-most in the country. In the 11-6 series finale victory over the Musketeers, Bishop matched his career-high with five RBIs.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK - Erik Miller, Jr., Stanford

Stanford's Erik Miller is tabbed Pac-12 Baseball Pitcher of the Week after picking up his second win of the season by setting a career high with 101 pitches, tying his career high in strikeouts (9) and season high in innings pitched (6) while surrendering just one hit in a 9-0 win over Texas on Sunday. In his four starts this season, the lefty boasts a team-high 29 strikeouts, allowing only six earned runs and a 1.19 WHIP.

PAC-12 BASEBALL COACHES VOTE UCLA AS 2019 FAVORITE

SAN FRANCISCO - In a polling of the Pac-12 baseball coaches, UCLA has been selected as the preseason favorite to win the Conference title for the 2019 season. This is the third time in program history and the first since 2015 that the Bruins were chosen to win the Pac-12, which was also the last time UCLA clinched the Conference crown.

Led by head coach **John Savage**, UCLA advanced to the 2018 Minnesota Regional in the NCAA Tournament, notching 38 or more wins for the fifth time in the last eight seasons. The Bruins return a strong nucleus of position players including 2018 All-Pac-12 selections in second baseman **Chase Strumpf**, first baseman **Michael Togli** and outfielder **Jeremy Ydens**. After finishing fourth in the Conference last year, the Bruins have now been ranked inside the top ten in every major national preseason poll released this offseason.

2018 Pac-12 Champion STANFORD was selected to finish second for the third-consecutive year. In head coach **David Esquer**'s first season at the helm, the Cardinal clinched its first league title since 2004, posted its second-highest winning percentage in program history (.793) and reached the NCAA Regional for the second-consecutive season. A consensus first team All-American, sophomore reliever **Jack Little** returns to the mound after tying a program record with 16 saves.

Under the direction of first year head coach and longtime associate head coach **Pat Bailey**, NCAA Champion OREGON STATE was tabbed to finish third. In 11 years with OSU, Bailey helped the program to the 2018 national championship, three trips to Omaha and nine overall postseason appearances. Bailey replaces retired legendary head coach Pat Casey, who led the Beavers to all three of its NCAA titles. The 2018 CWS Most Outstanding Player **Adley Rutschman** is back behind the plate after setting a school record 102 hits and 83 runs batted in last season.

ARIZONA finished fourth with 67 points and WASHINGTON, a year after reaching the NCAA College World Series for the first time in program history, totaled 56 points to round out the top five.

ARIZONA STATE takes the sixth spot with 59 points and OREGON tallied 49 points for seventh. CALIFORNIA received 37 points for eighth and USC was tabbed to finish ninth with 32 points. WASHINGTON STATE is 10th with 15 points and UTAH totaled 14 points for 11th.

The 2019 Pac-12 baseball campaign begins Friday, Feb. 15 with all 11 teams competing, featuring Oregon State in the Sanderson Ford College Baseball Classic and California and Stanford competing in the Angels College Classic.
