PAC-12 NOTES

PREVIEWING THE WEEK: The Pac-12 boasts the top-three ranked teams in the nation in the USA Today Coaches Poll as well as the last remaining undefeated team in the country in No. 10 Arizona State. After a thrilling first week of Pac-12 play, week two has pivotal matchups between historic programs in No. 1 UCLA and Arizona, top Pac-12 talent battling it out in California vs. No. 2 Oregon State, and ASU putting its perfect 19-0 record to the test against Oregon.

The Bruins' pitching staff and defense has vaulted the team into the No. 1 spot in the country in four national polls. UCLA's pitchers claim the second-best ERA in the nation (2.21) and hits allowed per nine innings average (5.96). The Bruin defense has a fielding percentage of 0.982, good for fifth-best. The Wildcats' offense looks to provide stiff competition as they rank second in the country in runs (211), on-base percentage (0.446) and slugging percentage (0.565).

OSU's **Adley Rutschman** and Cal's **Andrew Vaughn**, two of the most talented hitters in the nation, face off against each other in a three-game tilt, with Friday and Sunday's games broadcast on Pac-12 Networks. Rutschman, the 2018 NCAA College World Series Most Outstanding Player and the projected Player of the Year by *Collegiate Baseball*, is leading the Pac-12 in batting average (.456) and on-base percentage (.619), while ranking third in the country with 26 walks. Vaughn, the reigning Golden Spikes Award Winner, ranks in the top three in the league in batting average (.426), slugging percentage (.895), on-base percentage (.593) and home runs (8).

WEEKLY RECAP: UCLA claimed the Conference opening series over the defending NCAA Champion Oregon State, 2-1. The Bruins started the series by blanking the Beavers, earning their nation-leading sixth shutout of the season. The shutout also notched head coach **John Savage's** 500th victory at UCLA, just the third coach in program history to reach that mark.

ASU needed a walk-off home run in game two and a clutch save from **Chaz Montoya** in the series finale to sweep Washington State and remain the lone undefeated team in the country. The Sun Devils have specifically improved their success in close games from last year, as ASU moved to 4-0 on the season in one-run games and 5-0 in games decided by two runs or less. The Devils were just 4-16 in games decided by two runs or less last season.

IN THE RANKINGS: Four Pac-12 teams are ranked in the top 10 in the latest USA Today coaches poll, including the top three spots. This is the first time four Conference teams were ranked in the top 10 since the 2013 preseason coaches poll. UCLA claimed the No. 1 spot from Oregon State and the Beavers move into a tie for second with Stanford. UCLA is the No. 1 team in the country for the first time since the final poll in 2013 after the Bruins won its first program NCAA title. Undefeated Arizona State moves up nine spots to No. 10. Also receiving votes are Oregon and Washington. The Bruins, Beavers, Cardinal and Sun Devils rank in the top-20 in all five national rankings.

Nine of 11 Pac-12 programs rank in the top 90 in RPI rankings. Oregon State tops the RPI list, with UCLA right behind at second, followed by Stanford and Oregon ranking fifth and seventh, respectively.

BY THE NUMBERS: Pac-12 pitchers have brought the heat this season, as four teams rank in the top 20 in ERA. UCLA has the second-best ERA in the nation at 2.21. Stanford's pitching staff has an ERA of 2.31, which is good for fifth-best. Arizona State is seventh-best at 2.34 and Oregon State comes in at 17th with a 2.83 ERA.

Also of note has been the league's stellar gloves in the field. Five Conference teams rank in the top 20 in fielding percentage, including UCLA at fifth (0.982) and Stanford at 12th with a 0.980 average. Washington State, Washington and Oregon all have a 0.979 average and rank 16th, 17th and 19th, respectively.

The league's top hitters have found ways to get on base this year at exceptionally high rates. Four student-athletes rank among the top 15 in on base percentage. OSU's **Adley Rutschman** has the second-best average (0.619) and Cal's **Andrew Vaughn** has the third-best (0.593). **Hunter Bishop** of ASU is 12th at 0.549 and rounding out the top 15 is Washington's **Nick Kahle** (0.548).

STAR POWER: Washington's speedy sophomore outfielder **Braiden Ward** has already collected a league-leading 14 stolen bases, which is also the 10th-most in the nation. He is the only player in the Conference to steal three bases in a game, and he has already done so three times this season. On top of that, his three triples on the year is the third-most in the Conference and matches his career-high through just 16 games this season. The Pac-12 single season record for most triples in a season is 15, set by Arizona's Trevor Crowe in 2005.

OSU's **Adley Rutschman** continues to impress, hitting safely in all four games for the Beavers last week with two home runs, nine runs batted in and five walks. His on-base percentage over the four games was .722 (13-for-18) and he capped the week by tying his career-best with four hits in the finale versus UCLA. He earns his first-career Pac-12 weekly honor.

Also earning his first-career weekly honor is UCLA righty starter **Zach Pettway**. The junior threw seven scoreless innings to help shut out No. 2 Oregon State, 8-0, on Friday in the Pac-12 opener. Pettway allowed just three hits and added eight strikeouts, the fourth time in five outings this year he has recorded eight or more punchouts.

GOLDEN SPIKES: The Pac-12 is home to eight Golden Spikes Award winners after **Andrew Vaughn** claimed the award last season, tying the ACC and SEC for most of any conference. This year, ten student-athletes from seven different league schools were named to the preseason Watch List, including Vaughn. He is just one of four Golden Spikes Award recipients all-time to return to school after winning the award. Oregon State, UCLA and Stanford each boast a pair of student-athletes on the prestigious list. The preseason watch list features 55 of the nation's top amateur players. The 42nd Golden Spikes Award will be presented on June 14, 2019.

Oregon State's **Adley Rutschman** wins his first career Pac-12 Player of the Week award after hitting safely in all four games for No. 2 Oregon State this week, including a 7-6 win over Oregon and a 1-2 record against No. 1 UCLA. Rutschman drew five walks in four games, upping his season total to 26 which is the second-most in the country. He currently boasts the best batting average (.456) and on base percentage (.619) in the Pac-12.

PAC-12 BASEBALL COACHES VOTE UCLA AS 2019 FAVORITE

SAN FRANCISCO - In a polling of the Pac-12 baseball coaches, UCLA has been selected as the preseason favorite to win the Conference title for the 2019 season. This is the third time in program history and the first since 2015 that the Bruins were chosen to win the Pac-12, which was also the last time UCLA clinched the Conference crown.

Led by head coach **John Savage**, UCLA advanced to the 2018 Minnesota Regional in the NCAA Tournament, notching 38 or more wins for the fifth time in the last eight seasons. The Bruins return a strong nucleus of position players including 2018 All-Pac-12 selections in second baseman **Chase Strumpf**, first baseman **Michael Togli** and outfielder **Jeremy Ydens**. After finishing fourth in the Conference last year, the Bruins have now been ranked inside the top ten in every major national preseason poll released this offseason.

2018 Pac-12 Champion STANFORD was selected to finish second for the third-consecutive year. In head coach **David Esquer**'s first season at the helm, the Cardinal clinched its first league title since 2004, posted its second-highest winning percentage in program history (.793) and reached the NCAA Regional for the second-consecutive season. A consensus first team All-American, sophomore reliever **Jack Little** returns to the mound after tying a program record with 16 saves.

Under the direction of first year head coach and longtime associate head coach **Pat Bailey**, NCAA Champion OREGON STATE was tabbed to finish third. In 11 years with OSU, Bailey helped the program to the 2018 national championship, three trips to Omaha and nine overall postseason appearances. Bailey replaces retired legendary head coach Pat Casey, who led the Beavers to all three of its NCAA titles. The 2018 CWS Most Outstanding Player **Adley Rutschman** is back behind the plate after setting a school record 102 hits and 83 runs batted in last season.

ARIZONA finished fourth with 67 points and WASHINGTON, a year after reaching the NCAA College World Series for the first time in program history, totaled 56 points to round out the top five.

ARIZONA STATE takes the sixth spot with 59 points and OREGON tallied 49 points for seventh. CALIFORNIA received 37 points for eighth and USC was tabbed to finish ninth with 32 points. WASHINGTON STATE is 10th with 15 points and UTAH totaled 14 points for 11th.

The 2019 Pac-12 baseball campaign begins Friday, Feb. 15 with all 11 teams competing, featuring Oregon State in the Sanderson Ford College Baseball Classic and California and Stanford competing in the Angels College Classic. Pac-12 Networks will broadcast over 95 baseball games this season, including 18 rivalry matchups as well as a two-game set featuring Oklahoma State at Oregon State May 4-5.
