PAC-12 NOTES

PREVIEWING THE WEEK: Four of the top six ranked team in the *USA Today* Coaches poll are Pac-12 teams, including No. 1 UCLA and No. 2 Stanford. The top-ranked Bruins and Cardinal face off in a three-game series this weekend at Sunken Diamond Stadium, which looks to be an intense pitcher's duel between two of the best defensive teams in the nation. No. 5 Arizona State heads to Los Angeles with the best winning percentage in the country (25-2, 0.926) to take on USC. The Sun Devils and Trojans boast two of the most successful collegiate baseball programs in history, as USC has the most NCAA titles with 12 and ASU has the third-most with five.

UCLA and Stanford have earned their top-rankings behind the stellar work of their pitching staffs. The Cardinal, at the top of the standings with a 6-0 Pac-12 record, boasts the best ERA in the nation at 2.36 and 12th-best WHIP (1.16). The Bruins have the third-best ERA at 2.54, the best WHIP average (1.04) and most shutouts with six. The Conference's best arms will be on the mound for this series, with Stanford's sophomore starter **Brendan Beck** claiming best strikeout-to-walk ratio in the league and sixth-best in the country at 12.00. UCLA's sophomore closer **Holden Powell** comes into the series with a league-leading seven saves. UCLA faces another ranked opponent later in the week, taking on No. 22 UC Irvine at home for one game.

WEEKLY RECAP: Arizona State is off to a historic program start of 25-2 after its first series sweep of crosstown rival Arizona since 2009. The Sun Devils were the last undefeated team in the country, starting the season 21-0 and matching the second-best start in program history (1961). Only the 2010 team that started 24-0 had a better start to the year.

Oregon State also broke a lengthy drought against Washington, sweeping the Huskies for the first time since 2005. **George Mendazona** hit a solo home run, the first of his career, in the 11th inning to send Oregon State to a 4-3 win over Washington Sunday and secure the three-game sweep.

MIDSEASON AWARDS WATCH: Halfway through the 2019 season, Pac-12 baseball's dominance is being recognized nationwide. Perfect Game recently announced its midseason awards, and honored the Pac-12 with three of its five awards. **Hunter Bishop** of ASU was named the midseason Player of the Year, as the national home run leader (16) is batting a ridiculous .417 with a 1.010 slugging percentage. UCLA skipper **John Savage** was named the midseason coach of the year for leading UCLA to near unanimous No. 1 rankings across the five national polls. Arizona State was tabbed the team of the year after being unranked in the preseason to opening the year as the only undefeated team left in the country and matching the second-best start in program history. Five Pac-12 student-athletes were named midseason first team All-Americans by Perfect Game, the most of any conference on the first team. Bishop, OSU's **Adley Rutschman** and **Brandon Eisert**, Cal's **Andrew Vaughn** and ASU's **Alec Marsh** all earned the nod.

Rutschman was also named to the Buster Posey National Collegiate Catcher of the Year Award watch list, along with four other league catchers. Seventy-nine catchers were nominated for the 2019 Buster Posey Award by their coaches, given annually to the top Division I collegiate catcher. The winner will be announced on June 27, 2019.

IN THE RANKINGS: Four Pac-12 teams are ranked in the top six in the latest USA Today Coaches poll, including the top two spots with No. 1 UCLA and No. 2 Stanford. The last time the Pac-12 claimed top two spots in the national poll was May 21, 2018 when Stanford was No. 1 and Oregon State was No. 2. ASU moved up four spots to No. 5 and Oregon State is No. 6. Washington also received votes. The Bruins, Cardinal, Sun Devils and Beavers rank in the top 10 in all five national polls.

Eight of 11 Pac-12 programs rank in the top 100 in the NCAA RPI rankings. Oregon State tops the RPI list, with UCLA right behind at second, followed by Arizona State at eighth. Stanford and Oregon rank 11th and 18th, respectively.

BY THE NUMBERS: Pac-12 pitchers have brought the heat this season as five teams rank in the top 30 in ERA, the most teams of any other conference to rank in the top 30 in that category. Stanford has the best ERA in the nation at 2.36. UCLA's pitching staff has an ERA of 2.54, which is good for third-best. Oregon State is 11th-best at 2.87, Washington comes in at 11th with a 2.87 ERA and Arizona State ranks 28th with an average of 3.35.

The league's top hitters have found ways to get on base this year at exceptionally high rates. Four student-athletes rank among the nation's top 15 in on base percentage. OSU's **Adley Rutschman** has the best average (0.592) and ASU's **Hunter Bishop** has the sixth-best (0.552). Washington's **Nick Kahle** ranks eighth at 0.547 and Cal's **Andrew Vaughn** is 15th at 0.530.

Scored runs have also come in bunches from Pac-12 student-athletes, with four ranking in the top 20 nationally. ASU's Bishop leads the nation with 45 runs and teammate **Trevor Hauver** ranks fifth with 39. **Cameron Cannon** of Arizona is 14th with 34 runs and ASU's **Spencer Torkelson** is 19th with 33 runs on the season.

STAR POWER: Washington's catcher **Nick Kahle** was on a tear in the month of March, batting .414 and reaching base in 16 of 17 games the Huskies played last month. He added 18 RBI, 2 home runs and 14 runs. The Buster Posey National Collegiate Catcher of the Year Award candidate is also a defensive asset behind the plate, throwing out six-of-seven attempted stolen bases against him in March.

ASU's **Hunter Bishop** continues his breakout year, winning his second-straight and third-career Pac-12 Player of the Week honor. The NCAA home run leader (16) homered in two straight games and batted .400 to lead the Sun Devils to a series sweep over Arizona for the first time since 2009. On top of leading the country in home runs and runs (45), Bishop also claims the best slugging percentage at a staggering 1.010, most total bases (104) and has the sixth-most RBI (41).

Oregon State's **Brandon Eisert** earned his first-career Pac-12 weekly honor after holding Washington to 6 1/3 scoreless innings, a new career-high, and stuck out nine to pick up his sixth win of the season, second-most in the country. Through nine appearances this year, the NCBWA Stopper of the Year candidate boasts the second-best ERA in the nation (0.30) and leads the Pac-12 in opposing batting average (0.157) and hits allowed (16).

GOLDEN SPIKES: The Pac-12 is home to eight Golden Spikes Award winners after **Andrew Vaughn** claimed the award last season, tying the ACC and SEC for most of any conference. This year, ten student-athletes from seven different league schools were named to the preseason Watch List, including Vaughn. He is just one of four Golden Spikes Award recipients all-time to return to school after winning the award. Oregon State, UCLA and Stanford each boast a pair of student-athletes on the prestigious list. The preseason watch list features 55 of the nation's top amateur players. The 42nd Golden Spikes Award will be presented on June 14, 2019.

PRESEASON NODS: The Pac-12 has 20 total preseason All-America selections from seven different schools. Six student-athletes were named to all five preseason All-America lists and 2018 Golden Spikes Award winner Cal's **Andrew Vaughn**, 2018 CWS Most Outstanding Player OSU's **Adley Rutschman** and All-Pac-12 selection UCLA's **Chase Strumpf** were named to the first team by five national outlets. Rutschman was also tabbed the Projected Player of the Year by *Collegiate Baseball*. *Baseball America* highlighted several league student-athletes as All-American Best Tools with Vaughn earning best hitter, Arizona State's **Spencer Torkelson** selected as the best power hitter and Rutschman tabbed as the best defensive catcher.

PLAYER/PITCHER OF THE WEEK

PLAYER OF THE WEEK - Hunter Bishop, Jr., OF, Arizona State

Arizona State's **Hunter Bishop** homered in two straight games and batted .400 on the series to lead the Sun Devils to a series sweep over Arizona for the first time since 2009. The NCAA home run leader (16) did almost as much damage without swinging the bat, drawing six walks for a .647 on-base-percentage. Bishop recorded four RBIs on four hits with two homers and a double for a 1.100 slugging percentage as well over the weekend.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK - Brandon Eisert, Jr., LHP, Oregon State

Oregon State lefty **Brandon Eisert** wins Pac-12 Baseball Pitcher of the Week honors for a dominant performance in the Beavers' 1-0 series-opening win over Washington. Eisert picked up his sixth win of the season in just his second career start. The junior held the Huskies to just four hits and two walks in a new career-high 6 1/3 innings while striking out nine batters. Through nine appearances this year, the NCBWA Stopper of the Year candidate boasts the second-best ERA in the nation (0.30) and leads the Pac-12 in opposing batting average (0.157) and hits allowed (16).

PAC-12 BASEBALL COACHES VOTE UCLA AS 2019 FAVORITE

SAN FRANCISCO - In a polling of the Pac-12 baseball coaches, UCLA has been selected as the preseason favorite to win the Conference title for the 2019 season. This is the third time in program history and the first since 2015 that the Bruins were chosen to win the Pac-12, which was also the last time UCLA clinched the Conference crown.

Led by head coach **John Savage**, UCLA advanced to the 2018 Minnesota Regional in the NCAA Tournament, notching 38 or more wins for the fifth time in the last eight seasons. The Bruins return a strong nucleus of position players including 2018 All-Pac-12 selections in second baseman **Chase Strumpf**, first baseman **Michael Togli** and outfielder **Jeremy Ydens**. After finishing fourth in the Conference last year, the Bruins have now been ranked inside the top ten in every major national preseason poll released this offseason.

2018 Pac-12 Champion STANFORD was selected to finish second for the third-consecutive year. In head coach **David Esquer's** first season at the helm, the Cardinal clinched its first league title since 2004, posted its second-highest winning percentage in program history (.793) and reached the NCAA Regional for the second-consecutive season. A consensus first team All-American, sophomore reliever **Jack Little** returns to the mound after tying a program record with 16 saves.

Under the direction of first year head coach and longtime associate head coach **Pat Bailey**, NCAA Champion OREGON STATE was tabbed to finish third. In 11 years with OSU, Bailey helped the program to the 2018 national championship, three trips to Omaha and nine overall postseason appearances. Bailey replaces retired legendary head coach Pat Casey, who led the Beavers to all three of its NCAA titles. The 2018 CWS Most Outstanding Player **Adley Rutschman** is back behind the plate after setting a school record 102 hits and 83 runs batted in last season.

ARIZONA finished fourth with 67 points and WASHINGTON, a year after reaching the NCAA College World Series for the first time in program history, totaled 56 points to round out the top five.

ARIZONA STATE takes the sixth spot with 59 points and OREGON tallied 49 points for seventh. CALIFORNIA received 37 points for eighth and USC was tabbed to finish ninth with 32 points. WASHINGTON STATE is 10th with 15 points and UTAH totaled 14 points for 11th.

The 2019 Pac-12 baseball campaign begins Friday, Feb. 15 with all 11 teams competing, featuring Oregon State in the Sanderson Ford College Baseball Classic and California and Stanford competing in the Angels College Classic. Pac-12 Networks will broadcast over 95 baseball games this season, including 18 rivalry matchups as well as a two-game set featuring Oklahoma State at Oregon State May 4-5.
