### **WASHINGTON HEAD COACH – LORENZO ROMAR**

On the outcome of the game...

"It's pretty simple. We had 17 turnovers and gave up 18 points off of turnovers. Against the Trojans, that's bad news. When we took care of the ball we were in control of the game, when we didn't they came back, or took the lead a little bit. You have to give them all the credit in the world though because that is what they do... I still want to give our guys a lot of credit though. Despite the record that we have and all the consecutive losses, to still come out and compete and play together the way we did. I'm very proud of our guys in that regard."

"I felt that Malik went out in his last game and left it all on the court. He gave us a very good performance."
