- 1** Via the NCAA Statistics conference trends rankings, the Pac-12 is first nationally in scoring average (78.0 ppg), rebound average (38.9 rpg) and block average (4.7 bpg) through Feb. 1 games.
- 10** Ten Pac-12 teams have an NCAA Strength of Schedule in the top 50, the most in the nation, with an 11th team (USC) just outside at 51.
- 10.2** **Every game is a battle in the Pac-12.** Through 54 league games as of Feb. 1:  
 >> Average scoring margin is 10.2 ppg.  
 >> 28 have been decided by single digits.  
 >> 11 have been decided by one possession (3 pts or less).  
 >> Five have gone to overtime, combining for nine total OT periods.  
 >> Five have been decided by a team's final possession (Bonam - UTAH @ COLO, Alford - UCLA vs ARIZ, R. Allen - STAN vs ASU, Brown - CAL vs ARIZ, Andrews - WASH @ UCLA).
- 11** The Pac-12's 11 teams in the NCAA RPI Top 75 as of Feb. 2 are the most in the nation. Four Pac-12 teams are currently in the top 25 and seven are in the top 50, both tied for the second-most nationally.
- 35** In the 37 seasons since expanding from the Pac-8 and to an 18-game schedule, the league's midway leader has gone on to earn at least a share of the regular-season crown 35 times (1994, 2013).

**HOME SWEET HOME:** OREGON now owns the Pac-12's longest and nation's ninth-best home court win streak at 20 straight games after the Ducks ended ARIZONA's national-best 49-game streak on Jan. 28. CALIFORNIA (14) and USC (14) are also enjoying lengthy home streaks, both tied for the 20th longest in the nation.

**ROAD TO VEGAS:** Only two teams have completed a road sweep in 24 attempts so far in league play (UTAH at WSU/ WASH, ORE at ARIZ/ASU).

Home-road results will be key in the second half of league play. Of the top six teams at the midway point, only COLORADO has fewer home dates (4) than road games (5) remaining.

## #PAC12HOOPS SUBS

**DOUBLE OSCARS FOR PAC-12:** After only three recipients in the award's first six years of existence, Pac-12 players earned back-to-back selections for the USBWA Oscar Robertson National Player of the Week award with UTAH's Jakob Poeltl on Jan. 26 and OREGON's Dillon Brooks on Feb. 2.

**TOP 100 CHARTS:** Through Feb. 1, the Pac-12 has 81 wins against NCAA RPI Top 100 teams, led by ARIZONA (8-5), CALIFORNIA (7-7), OREGON (12-3), UCLA (7-8), USC (8-5), UTAH (11-5).

The Pac-12 has 34 total wins versus the RPI Top 50, paced by CALIFORNIA (4-5), OREGON (6-1), USC (4-4) and UTAH (6-4).

WASHINGTON (3-3) boasts three of the Pac-12's 14 RPI Top 25 wins, tied for the fifth-most in the nation.

**FIRST TO 90 WINS?:** There have been 17 instances of a Pac-12 team reaching the 90-point plateau through the 54 total league games of Feb. 1, five more than the 12 from the entire 2014-15 Pac-12 season.

**TOPPLING THE TOP 25:** Pac-12 teams posted a combined seven wins against Top 25 teams in non-conference play, tied for the third-most in the nation behind the ACC and SEC. Five of those upsets came in a span of 20 days (11/30-12/19). In total, Pac-12 teams have combined for 17 Top 25 wins, including road sweeps of ARIZONA, UCLA and UTAH in the opening two weeks of league play.

**ROAD TO RIO PAVED BY PAC-12:** USA Basketball released its list of the 30 finalists for its 2016 U.S. Olympic Men's National Team roster on Jan. 18 and the Pac-12 Conference had the most former players listed with six:

## PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK

### DILLON BROOKS, OREGON Sophomore, 6-6, F, Mississauga, Ontario

Sophomore **Dillon Brooks** led nationally ranked No. 16 OREGON to its first road sweep of the league's Arizona schools since 2012 to earn his first career Pac-12 Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week nod as voted upon by media members who cover the league.

Brooks averaged a team-best 21.0 points on 50 percent shooting (15-30) as OREGON became the first Pac-12 school in four years to earn a road sweep of ARIZONA and ARIZONA STATE.

The 6-6 forward from Mississauga, Ontario scored a game-high 24 points on 10-of-19 shooting in the Ducks' 83-75 victory at then No. 18 ARIZONA on Thursday, a win which snapped the Wildcats' national-best 49-game home win streak. He followed with 18 points and six rebounds in a 91-74 triumph at ARIZONA STATE on Sunday night.

Brooks paces four Ducks scoring in double figures with 16.6 points per game, good for fifth in the Pac-12. He is the ninth different Pac-12 standout from eight different league schools to claim a Player of the Week nod this season.

## PAC-12 CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION



**#100Pac12:** The Pac-12 Conference is set to celebrate 100 years of excellence. The yearlong celebration of the Conference centennial, including marking the date of the official formation 100 years ago on December 2, will kick off with the start of the football season and continue throughout the 2015-16 academic year.

The Conference's storied history dates back 100 years to Dec. 2, 1915 when four schools - the University of California, Oregon Agricultural College (now Oregon State University), the University of Oregon and the University of Washington - gathered at the historic Imperial Hotel in Portland, Ore., to form the Pacific Coast Conference.

Since that day, the Conference has been known for its widespread excellence - on the field, in the classroom, and with the contributions its graduates make in the world. No other Conference can match the collective achievements and distinctions accomplished over the last century.

The Conference has been home to some of sports' legendary athletes and coaches. Dubbed the "Conference of Champions," Pac-12 schools have won 478 NCAA titles, by far more than any other conference, as well as over 2,000 individual national championships.
