## #PAC12HOOPS STARTING FIVE

A national-best three Pac-12 teams are ranked in the top 10 of this week's AP Top 25 poll in #5 OREGON, #9 ARIZONA and #10 UCLA. It marks the second time this season the league placed three teams in the top 10.

>> The Conference last had three top 10 teams in multiple weeks during the 1998-99 season (three weeks).

Thursday's rematch featuring #5 OREGON at #10 UCLA will mark the fifth Conference clash between two ranked teams so far in this Pac-12 season, the most regular-season meetings of ranked league teams since 2008-09.

>> Between the 2009-10 and 2014-15 seasons, there were three *total* regular-season ranked matchups in Pac-12 play. There now will be nine total during past two seasons.

Seven Pac-12 teams rate inside the top 80 of the NCAA RPI rankings as of Feb. 7 (OREGON, ARIZONA, UCLA, USC, CALIFORNIA, STANFORD, UTAH), including five in the top 50, four in the top 30, and two in the top 12.

>> 11 Pac-12 teams have NCAA Strengths of Schedule inside the top 100.

### PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK 2/6/17

**Dillon Brooks, OREGON**

- Wooden Award midseason top 25 selection and Erving Award finalist Dillon Brooks earned his third career Pac-12 Player of the Week award.
- Averaged 22.5 points, 5.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.0 steals as Oregon extended its national-best home court winning streak to 40 games.

## PAC-12 TIPOFF

**DRAWING A CROWD:** 66 games into the 108-game Pac-12 slate, league contests are drawing 8,449 fans per game. That mark would be the highest average since the formation of the Pac-12 for 2011-12, besting the 8,380 during 2015-16, which featured a 7,889 average through 68 league games.

**ROAD RARITIES:** Of the 30 two-game Conference road swings so far in 2016-17, seven teams have completed sweeps:

OREGON at WASH/WSU  
ARIZONA at CAL/STAN & USC/UCLA  
UCLA at COLO/UTAH & WSU/WASH  
USC at WASH/WSU  
UTAH at WSU/WASH

During the 2015-16 season, only six times in 48 swings did a Pac-12 team complete a road sweep.

## PAC-12 TIPOFF

**HOME SWEET HOME:** Two Pac-12 teams have built double-digit home court winning streaks. OREGON owns the nation's longest home streak at 40 consecutive games, while ARIZONA has won its last 18 at home, good for a tie for seventh nationally.

**INSIDE THE RANKINGS:** ARIZONA's 92 consecutive weeks in the AP Top 25 dates back to 2013 and is the second-longest nationally behind Kansas' streak of 156. OREGON's stretch of 22 consecutive appearances is its longest in program history, surpassing 21 from 2007-08.

**WEST COAST BLOCK PARTY:** Five Pac-12 teams are ranked inside the national top 30 in blocked shots: OREGON (1st, 7.3 bpg), WASHINGTON (4th, 6.2 bpg), USC (12th, 5.7 bpg) and UCLA (18th, 5.5 bpg) and CALIFORNIA (28th, 5.2 bpg).

## RECORDS WATCH

ARIZONA's **Sean Miller** is the 21st coach in league history to reach 100 career Conference victories. His .737 winning percentage in league games (101-36) is fourth to only **John Wooden** (.810), **Lute Olson** (.764) and **Jim Harrick** (.743) among those to reach the 100-win plateau.

OREGON (7.3 bpg, 1st in NCAA) is ahead of WASHINGTON's Pac-12 single-season record block mark of 6.59 set last season.

At his current clip of 23.2 points per game, WASHINGTON's **Markelle Fultz** is aiming to become the first freshman to lead the league in scoring since CALIFORNIA's **Shareef Abdur-Rahim** in 1995-96 (Conference freshman record 21.1 ppg). Fultz would be only the third freshmen to pace the league in scoring along with **Abdur-Rahim** and **Cliff Robinson** (USC, 1977-78).

With 188 assists, UCLA's **Lonzo Ball** is already fourth on the Pac-12's freshman single-season assists list. At 7.8 apg, he's on pace to shatter the rookie mark of 229 set by OREGON STATE's Gary Payton in 1986-87.

UCLA's **Bryce Alford** has entered the Pac-12 career top 10 in three-point field goals as his 291 triples (5th active in NCAA, most among Power 6 players) are eighth all-time. Alford's 1,757 career points are the most among active players from Power 6 programs (15th active in NCAA) and rank 46th in Conference history just behind Bill Walton's 1,767.

The 52 career double-doubles for WASHINGTON STATE senior **Josh Hawkinson** are the highest active total in NCAA Division I. Hawkinson is also third among active Division I players in rebounding with 932 career caroms, a total which currently ranks 26th in Pac-12 history.

OREGON junior **Jordan Bell** (200 blocks) has moved into seventh on the Pac-12's career blocked shots list, while COLORADO senior **Wesley Gordon** (194 blocks) is just behind in ninth and OREGON's **Chris Boucher** (172) is fast approaching.

## PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK

### DILLON BROOKS, OREGON Junior, 6-7, F, Mississauga, Ontario

- Wooden Award midseason top 25 selection and Erving Award finalist Dillon Brooks earned his third career Pac-12 Player of the Week award.
- Brooks averaged 22.5 points on 67 percent shooting (16-24), including 7-of-12 behind the arc, along with 5.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.0 steals as Oregon extended its national-best home court winning streak to 40 games with triumphs over Arizona State and No. 5 Arizona.
- With Oregon trailing by one with 3:15 remaining, Brooks scored his team's final 12 points to propel the Ducks to a 71-70 victory over the Sun Devils on Thursday. He finished with team-best 27 points (9-14 FG, 3-5 3FG, 6-8 FT), six rebounds and four assists.
- Followed up with 18 points (7-10 FG, 4-7 3FG), five rebounds, three assists and three steals in just 22 minutes in Oregon's 85-58 victory over Arizona on Saturday, its largest margin over a top-10 opponent in program history.
- Brooks' third weekly honor is tied for the second-most ever by an Oregon player with Jerry Adams and Kenya Wilkins. Blair Rasmussen is the Ducks' all-time leader with four selections.

## GROWING THE PAC-12 GLOBAL GAME

// This past July, 12 student-athletes from 10 Pac-12 schools traveled to Australia for three exhibition games, two of which came against the Australian National Team - nicknamed The Boomers - in its prep for the 2016 Rio Olympic Games. The Boomers prevailed in both games - 92-83 and 93-63 - en route to fourth place in Rio.

// Following the All-Star tour of Australia in July, the Pac-12 and FOX Sports Australia have reached a multi-year partnership to televise league games in the country - 21 games including a Game of the Week and eight Pac-12 Tournament games will air in Australia in 2016-17.

// 29 international student-athletes from 20 different countries appear on Pac-12 rosters for 2016-17, including multiple players from Canada (7), Democratic Republic of Congo (2), England (2) and Senegal (2).

## #PAC12HOOPS IN THE PROS

A total of 56 former Pac-12 student-athletes appeared on 2016-17 NBA opening day rosters. All but one Pac-12 member institution has representation in the NBA, with UCLA (13), Arizona (12) and Washington (8) among the top-10 programs in the nation. The Pac-12 had five players taken in the latest NBA Draft, including an NCAA-best three in the lottery, and have had 28 players selected over the last four years.

## PAC-12 TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE-SEEDING & TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES

**Seeding:** The seedings and pairings shall be determined upon completion of regular season play on Saturday, March 4. The won-lost percentage record of the teams in regular season Conference play will determine tournament seedings. The team with the best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #1, the next best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #2, and so forth through all the seeds.

**Tie-Breakers:** Tie breaking procedures for determining all tournament seeding will be:

### 1. Two-team tie

- Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
- Each team's record (won-lost percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular standings, and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (won-lost percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

- Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
- Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.

### 2. Multiple-team tie

- Results (won-lost percentage) of collective head-to-head competition during the regular season among the tied teams.
- If more than two teams are still tied, each of the tied team's record (won-lost percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings, eliminating teams with inferior records, until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (won-lost percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

If at any point the multiple-team tie is reduced to two teams, the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

- Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
- Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.
