Of the Pac-12's four NCAA Tournament teams, three earned a No. 3 seed or better, marking the fourth time in league history three teams were seeded as high.

>> 1981: #1 OSU, #2 ASU, #3 UCLA; 1992: #1 UCLA (E8), #2 USC, #3 ARIZ; 2007: #2 UCLA (F4), #3 ORE (E8), #3 WSU; **2017: #2 ARIZ, #3 ORE, #3 UCLA.**

For the first time in Conference history, three teams have reached at least 29 overall victories. It was also the first time three teams reached the 25-victory plateau during the regular season.

>> Should USC reach 25 wins, it would tie the Conference record of four 25-win teams in a single season (2006-07). Only once have multiple teams reached 30 wins (1997-98: ARIZ & STAN, both 30).

Three consecutive years the Pac-12 has advanced a team to the Elite Eight - the only conference in the country to accomplish the feat (2014 - ARIZONA; 2015 - ARIZONA; 2016 - OREGON).

>> The Pac-12 has also had a Sweet 16 participant in each of the last four seasons.

Three Pac-12 teams are ranked in the top 10 of this week's AP Top 25 poll in #4 ARIZONA, #8 UCLA and #9 OREGON - joining the ACC as the only conferences in the nation with three in the top 10.

>> It marks the seventh week this season the league placed three teams in the top 10, equaling the longest stretch in league history:

1997-98: 7 weeks (12/23/97 - 2/3/98); **2016-17: 7 weeks (1/23/17, 2/6/17 - 3/13/17)**

The Pac-12 placed seven teams in postseason play, with four teams earning berths in the 2017 NCAA Tournament (#2 ARIZONA, #3 OREGON, #3 UCLA, #11 USC) and another three being selected for the 2017 National Invitation Tournament (#1 CALIFORNIA, #3 UTAH, #5 COLORADO).

>> It marks the fourth time in the past five years that seven-or-more Pac-12 teams reached the NCAA or NIT.

BACK: The NCAA Final Four will return to the West for the first time in 22 years when Pac-12 member ARIZONA STATE hosts at University of Phoenix Stadium in Glendale, Ariz., April 1 and 3. The last time the event was staged in the West was in 1995 in Seattle where UCLA won its record 11th national championship.



In addition, the Pac-12 Conference will serve as a tournament site host for the first time at the West Regional in San Jose's SAP Center. League member UTAH will host the First and Second Rounds in Salt Lake City.

PAC-12 IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

The Pac-12 Conference has won more NCAA basketball titles (16) than any other conference in the country . . . Oregon's Tall Firs won the first NCAA Championship in 1939. Stanford claimed the national title in 1942, followed by Utah in 1944 and California in 1959 . . . UCLA established a basketball dynasty that included 10 titles in 12 seasons and a winning streak of seven consecutive NCAA crowns . . . In 1997, Arizona became the sixth different Pac-12 institution to capture the NCAA basketball title.

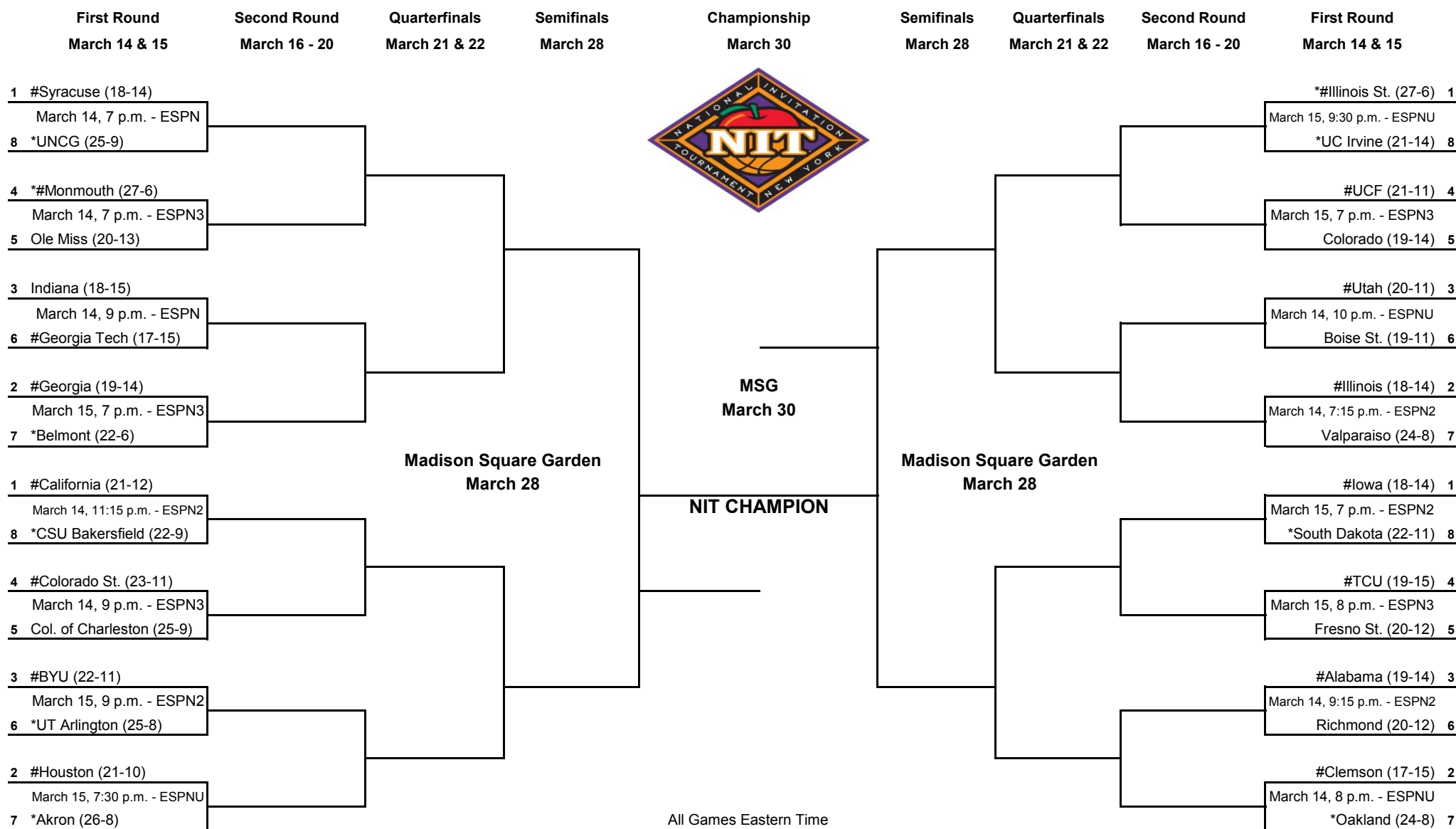

PAC-12 IN THE POSTSEASON NIT

The Pac-12 has had considerable success in the National Invitation Tournament (NIT), as five current members have captured the NIT crown - Colorado (1940), Utah (1947), UCLA (1985), Stanford (1991, 2012, 2015) and California (1999). Colorado also finished second in 1991, as did Utah in 1974. Meanwhile third-place finishes were turned in by Oregon in 1975 and 2004, Colorado in 1955 and 2011, Utah in 1992, and Washington State in 2011. The league now stands at 99-81 (.550) in America's original postseason tourney. The records of all Pac-12 members in the NIT:

RECORDS WATCH

ARIZONA's **Sean Miller** is the 21st coach in league history to reach 100 career Conference victories. His .743 winning percentage in league games (107-37) is third to only **John Wooden** (.810) and **Lute Olson** (.764) among those to reach 100 wins.

OREGON (6.8 bpg, 2nd in NCAA) has already set a new single-season league record with 226 blocked shots, eclipsing the previous mark of 225 set by WASHINGTON last season.

ARIZONA STATE (328) and UCLA (327) are only the fourth and fifth teams in league history to reach 300 made three pointers in a season along with OREGON (350 in 2007, 304 in 2002) and WASHINGTON (305 in 2011).

While not on pace to break marks, UCLA's offense has proven to be one of the most-prolific in modern Conference and Division I history as it would rank among the best of the past three-plus decades in several categories:

>> 90.4 PPG - highest in league since 1997-98 (ARIZ, 90.8), highest nationally since 2008-09 (VMI, 93.8)
>> 51.9% FG - highest in league since 1996-97 (UCLA, 52.0%), highest nationally since 2006-07 (Florida, 52.6%)
>> 21.5 APG - highest in league since assists became official NCAA stat in 1983-84, highest recorded in Conference since 1979-80 (OSU, 21.7), highest nationally since 1995-96 (Kentucky, 21.8)
>> 327 3FG - 3rd-most in a season in league history

At his clip of 23.2 points per game, WASHINGTON's **Markelle Fultz** became the first freshman to lead the league in scoring since CALIFORNIA's **Shareef Abdur-Rahim** in 1995-96 (Conference freshman record 21.1 ppg). Fultz is only the third freshmen to pace the league in scoring along with Abdur-Rahim and **Cliff Robinson** (USC, 1977-78).

With 254 assists, UCLA's **Lonzo Ball** has shattered the Pac-12 freshman single-season assists mark and is fourth on the all-time single-season list. At 7.7 apg, he would need six more games to break the league record of 294 set by ARIZONA STATE's **Ahlon Lewis** in 1998. Ball is on pace to be the first Conference player to average at least 14 points, seven assists and six rebounds in a season since CALIFORNIA's **Jason Kidd** in 1993-94.

UCLA's **Bryce Alford** has entered the Pac-12 career top 10 in three-point field goals as his 320 triples (5th active in NCAA) are fourth most all-time. Alford's 1,887 career points are the second-most among active players from Power 6 programs (Josh Hart, Villanova) and rank 25th in Conference history.

ARIZONA STATE's **Torian Graham** (108 3FG) and UCLA's **Bryce Alford** (107 3FG) have cracked the Conference's single-season top 10 in made threes, currently in sixth and seventh places, respectively. ARIZONA's **Salim Stoudamire** set the mark of 120 set in 2005.

The 56 career double-doubles for WASHINGTON STATE senior **Josh Hawkinson** are the highest active total in NCAA Division I. Hawkinson is also fourth among active Division I players in rebounding with 1,015 career caroms, a total which ranks 12th in Pac-12 history.

OREGON junior **Jordan Bell** (219 blocks) has moved into sixth on the Pac-12's career blocked shots list, while COLORADO senior **Wesley Gordon** (203 blocks) is just behind in eighth and OREGON's **Chris Boucher** (189) is two shy of the top 10.

2017 PAC-12 TOURNAMENT

Allonzo Trier was named Most Outstanding Player in helping No. 7 Arizona outlast No. 5 Oregon 83-80 on Saturday, March 11 in the Pac-12 Tournament championship game. It marked the first Conference title game between two AP top 10 opponents.

The Wildcats and Trier - who missed three of Arizona's four losses due to a 19-game suspension - got their payback by avenging their only two regular-season league losses to UCLA and Oregon en route to a sixth tourney title and second in the last three seasons.

In the event's first year in Las Vegas' new T-Mobile Arena, the tournament set records for highest-attended quarter-final session (18,153, Session 4), highest-ever single-session attendance (19,224, Session 5), and total all-session attendance (86,910).
