A Conference tournament champion will be crowned for the 20th time as the 2017 Pac-12 Men's Basketball Tournament presented by New York Life makes its debut in new 18,000-seat T-Mobile Arena in Las Vegas this week. The tourney, which started with a four-year run from 1987-90, has been played each year since 2002, including the past five years in Las Vegas.

For the first time in Conference tournament history, three teams will enter the event with Associated Press top 10 rankings.

For the first time in Conference history, three teams have reached the 25-victory plateau during the regular season.

>> Should USC become the fourth team to reach 25 wins, it would tie the Conference record of four 25-win teams in a single season (2006-07).

Three Pac-12 teams are ranked in the top 10 of this week's AP Top 25 poll in #3 UCLA, #5 OREGON and #7 ARIZONA - the only conference in the nation with three in the top 10.

>> It marks the sixth week this season the league placed three teams in the top 10, the second-longest stretch in league history:

1997-98: 7 weeks (12/23/97 - 2/3/98); **2016-17: 6 weeks (1/23/17, 2/6/17 - 3/6/17)**

### PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK 3/6/17

**Jordan McLaughlin, USC**

- Led USC to a pair of home wins by averaging 19.0 points, 9.5 assists, 6.5 rebounds and 3.0 steals while converting 61 percent (14-23) of his shots, including 55 percent (6-11) from three-point range.

- First USC player to earn multiple weekly honors in same season since Harold Miner won three in 1991-92.

## PAC-12 TIPOFF

**DRAWING A CROWD:** This season's 108-game Pac-12 slate drew an average of 8,737 fans per game, besting the previous mark of 8,380 set during 2015-16.

**EVERY GAME'S A BATTLE:** Through 106 league games as of March 4:

>> Average scoring margin is 13.4 ppg.

>> 48 have been decided by single digits.

>> 16 have been decided by one possession (3 pts or less).

>> 9 decided by a team's final possession.

>> 3 overtime games (4 total OT periods), tied for fourth fewest in Conference season since 1979.

**MUST-SEE MATCHUPS:** The 2016-17 Pac-12 regular season featured six clashes between ranked teams, the most in the league since 2007-08 including the seventh meeting of top-5 teams (#5 UCLA at #4 Arizona) in Conference history.

**INSIDE THE POLLS:** ARIZONA's 96 consecutive weeks in the AP Top 25 dates back to 2013 and is the second-longest nationally behind Kansas' streak of 160. OREGON's stretch of 26 consecutive appearances is its longest in program history.

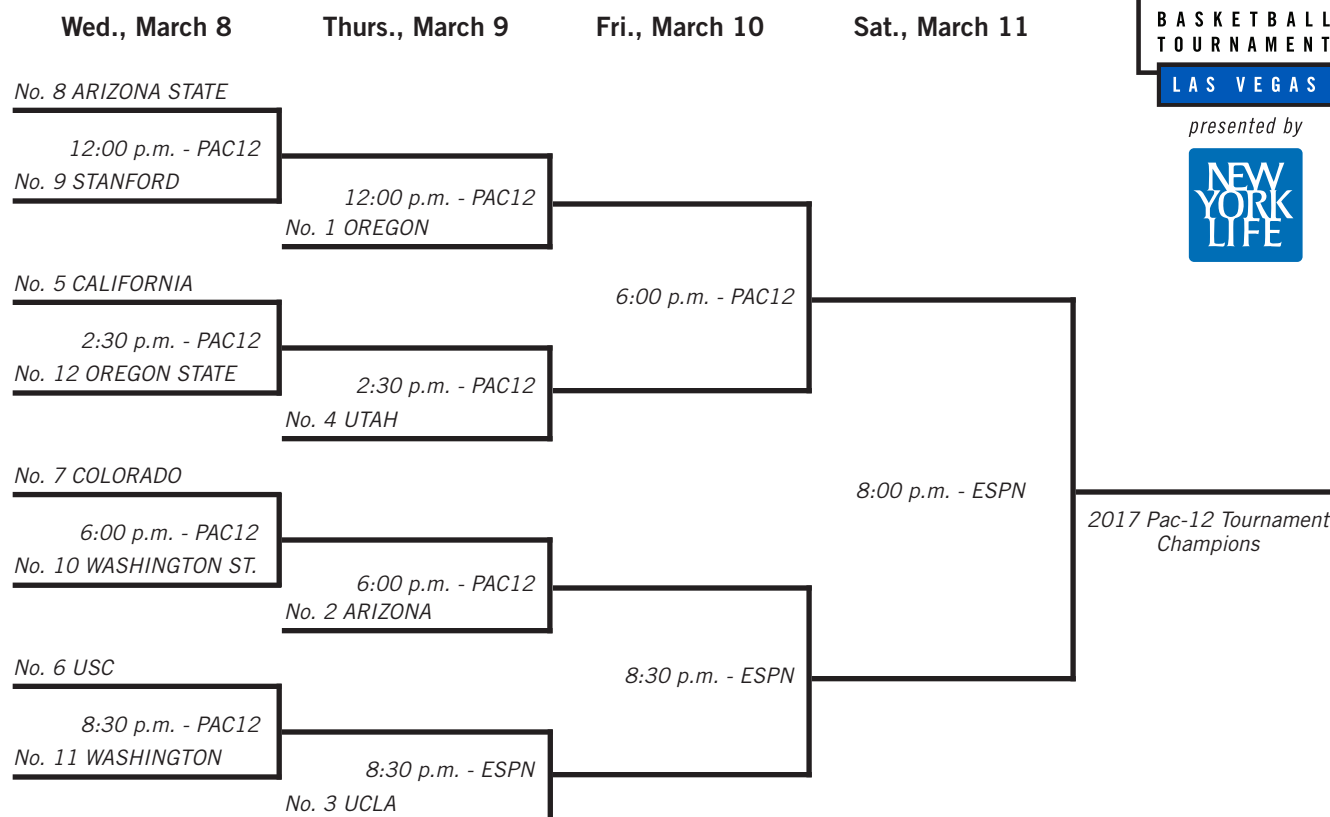

## RECORDS WATCH

ARIZONA's **Sean Miller** is the 21st coach in league history to reach 100 career Conference victories. His .743 winning percentage in league games (107-37) is third to only **John Wooden** (.810) and **Lute Olson** (.764) among those to reach 100 wins.

OREGON (6.8 bpg, 2nd in NCAA) is ahead of WASHINGTON's Pac-12 single-season record block mark of 6.59 set last season.

UCLA (314) and ARIZONA STATE (309) are only the fourth and fifth teams in league history to reach 300 made three pointers in a season along with OREGON (350 in 2007), WASHINGTON (305 in 2011), and OREGON (304 in 2002).

While not on pace to break marks, UCLA's offense has proven to be one of the most-prolific in modern Conference and Division I history as it would rank among the best of the past three-plus decades in several categories:

>> 91.3 PPG - highest in league since 1990-91 (UCLA, 92.3), highest nationally since 2008-09 (VMI, 93.8)

>> 52.6% FG - highest in league since 1995-96 (UCLA, 52.8%), highest nationally since 2006-07 (Florida, 52.6%)

>> 21.7 APG - highest in league since assists became official NCAA stat in 1983-84, highest recorded in Conference since 1979-80 (OSU, 21.7), highest nationally since 1995-96 (Kentucky, 21.8)

>> 314 3FG - 2nd-most in a season in league history

At his current clip of 23.2 points per game, WASHINGTON's **Markelle Fultz** is aiming to become the first freshman to lead the league in scoring since CALIFORNIA's **Shareef Abdur-Rahim** in 1995-96 (Conference freshman record 21.1 ppg). Fultz would be only the third freshman to pace the league in scoring along with Abdur-Rahim and **Cliff Robinson** (USC, 1977-78). He's on pace to be the first Division I player since 1997-98 to average at least 23 points, five rebounds and five assists in a season.

With 241 assists, UCLA's **Lonzo Ball** has set a new Pac-12 freshman single-season assists mark and is seventh on the all-time single-season list. At 7.8 apg, he would need seven more games to break the league record of 294 set by ARIZONA STATE's **Ahlon Lewis** in 1998. Ball is on pace to be the first Conference player to average at least 14 points, seven assists and six rebounds in a season since Jason Kidd in 1993-94.

UCLA's **Bryce Alford** has entered the Pac-12 career top 10 in three-point field goals as his 317 triples (5th active in NCAA) are tied for fifth all-time. Alford's 1,874 career points are the most among active players from Power 6 programs (17th active in NCAA) and rank 26th in Conference history.

UCLA's **Bryce Alford** (104 3FG) has cracked the Conference's single-season top 10 in made threes, currently in seventh place and 16 shy of Salim Stoudamire's record mark of 120 set in 2005. ARIZONA STATE's **Torian Graham** (98 3FG) is close behind tied for eighth.

The 55 career double-doubles for WASHINGTON STATE senior **Josh Hawkinson** are the highest active total in NCAA Division I. Hawkinson is also fourth among active Division I players in rebounding with 1,003 career caroms, a total which currently ranks 12th in Pac-12 history.

OREGON junior **Jordan Bell** (211 blocks) has moved into sixth on the Pac-12's career blocked shots list, while COLORADO senior **Wesley Gordon** (200 blocks) is just behind in eighth and OREGON's **Chris Boucher** (186) is five shy of the top 10.

## PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK

### JORDAN MCLAUGHLIN, USC Junior, 6-1, G, Etiwanda, Calif.

- **Jordan McLaughlin** earned his second Pac-12 Player of the Week award of the season, the final weekly honor of the 2016-17 campaign, in voting conducted by media who cover the league.
- McLaughlin led USC to a pair of home wins by averaging 19.0 points, 9.5 assists, 6.5 rebounds and 3.0 steals while converting 61 percent (14-23) of his shots, including 55 percent (6-11) from three-point range.
- The 6-1 guard from Etiwanda, Calif., narrowly missed the second triple-double in USC program history with 16 points, 10 assists and a career-high nine rebounds in an 87-64 victory over Washington State on Wednesday.
- He followed up with a team-high 22 points on 8-of-11 shooting, nine assists and four steals as the Trojans closed the regular season with a 74-58 triumph over Washington to reach 10 league wins for the first time since 2011.
- McLaughlin is the first USC player to earn multiple weekly honors in the same season since Harold Miner won three as a junior during the 1991-92 campaign.

## GROWING THE PAC-12 GLOBAL GAME

// This past July, 12 student-athletes from 10 Pac-12 schools traveled to Australia for three exhibition games, two of which came against the Australian National Team - nicknamed The Boomers - in its prep for the 2016 Rio Olympic Games. The Boomers prevailed in both games - 92-83 and 93-63 - en route to fourth place in Rio.

// Following the All-Star tour of Australia in July, the Pac-12 and FOX Sports Australia have reached a multi-year partnership to televise league games in the country - 21 games including a Game of the Week and eight Pac-12 Tournament games will air in Australia in 2016-17.

// 29 international student-athletes from 20 different countries appear on Pac-12 rosters for 2016-17, including multiple players from Canada (7), Democratic Republic of Congo (2), England (2) and Senegal (2).

## #PAC12HOOPS IN THE PROS

A total of 56 former Pac-12 student-athletes appeared on 2016-17 NBA opening day rosters. All but one Pac-12 member institution has representation in the NBA, with UCLA (13), Arizona (12) and Washington (8) among the top-10 programs in the nation. The Pac-12 had five players taken in the latest NBA Draft, including an NCAA-best three in the lottery, and have had 28 players selected over the last four years.

## PAC-12 TOURNAMENT

### STRUCTURE-SEEDING & TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES

**Seeding:** The seedings and pairings shall be determined upon completion of regular season play on Saturday, March 4. The won-lost percentage record of the teams in regular season Conference play will determine tournament seedings. The team with the best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #1, the next best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #2, and so forth through all the seeds.

**Tie-Breakers:** Tie breaking procedures for determining all tournament seeding will be:

#### 1. Two-team tie

- Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
- Each team's record (won-lost percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular standings, and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (won-lost percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

- Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
- Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.

#### 2. Multiple-team tie

- Results (won-lost percentage) of collective head-to-head competition during the regular season among the tied teams.
- If more than two teams are still tied, each of the tied team's record (won-lost percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings, eliminating teams with inferior records, until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (won-lost percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

If at any point the multiple-team tie is reduced to two teams, the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

- Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
- Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.

## 2016-17 PAC-12 MEN'S BASKETBALL ALL-CONFERENCE HONORS

**OREGON'S DILLON BROOKS NAMED MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR;  
UCLA'S LONZO BALL EARNS FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR HONORS;  
OREGON'S JORDAN BELL TABBED DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR;  
USC'S CHIMEZIE METU EARNS MOST IMPROVED PLAYER OF THE YEAR;  
ARIZONA'S SEAN MILLER SELECTED AS THE JOHN R. WOODEN COACH OF THE YEAR**

**SAN FRANCISCO** – In a vote of the 12 Conference coaches, OREGON junior forward **Dillon Brooks** has been chosen the 2016-17 Pac-12 Men's Basketball Player of the Year; UCLA guard **Lonzo Ball** was named Pac-12 Freshman of the Year; OREGON junior forward **Jordan Bell** was selected the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year; USC sophomore forward **Chimezie Metu** was tabbed Pac-12 Most Improved Player of the Year; and **Sean Miller** of ARIZONA claimed the John R. Wooden Coach of the Year honor, Commissioner Larry Scott announced today.

### **PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE YEAR: DILLON BROOKS, OREGON**

The second Duck to be named Pac-12 Player of the Year in the past three years, BROOKS is the fifth Oregon player ever to capture the award along with former teammate Joseph Young, Luke Ridnour, Terrell Brandon and Ron Lee. Slowed by a foot injury at the outset of the season, Brooks quickly regained his preseason Associated Press First Team All-American form to help the Ducks to an 11-2 non-conference mark.

Brooks went on to average 17.9 points in Conference play, third-best in the league, and led the Ducks with 35 triples in Pac-12 games. Two of those threes proved critical, as his buzzer-beating, game-winning shots in victories over UCLA and California helped Oregon repeat as Pac-12 regular-season champions, earning a share with Arizona at 16-2. Brooks is one of a national-best four John R. Wooden National Player of the Year finalists from the Pac-12.

### **PAC-12 FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR: LONZO BALL, UCLA**

BALL is the ninth UCLA player to earn the Pac-12 Freshman or Rookie of the Year award, joining Pooh Richardson, Don MacLean, Baron Davis, Jason Kapon, Jordan Farmer, Luc Richard Mbah a Moute, Kevin Love and Shabazz Muhammad. The Chino Hills, Calif., native and National Player and Freshman of the Year finalist has been the catalyst to the Bruins' 13.5-game improvement from 2015-16, the second-best turnaround in college basketball this season.

Ball paces the Pac-12 with a league record for assists by a freshman with 241 (7.8 apg), eclipsing Gary Payton's previous mark of 229. He's also second in the Pac-12 in steals (2.0 spg), 14th in scoring (14.9 ppg) and 16th in rebounding (6.2 rpg), putting him on pace to be the first Conference player to average at least 14 points, seven assists and six rebounds in a season since California's Jason Kidd in 1993-94.

### **PAC-12 DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR: JORDAN BELL, OREGON**

BELL is the first Oregon player to claim the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year award in its 14 years of existence. He teamed with fellow All-Defensive Team selection Chris Boucher to help the Ducks post 6.8 blocks per game, second-best in the nation and on pace to break the Pac-12 single-season record. He's the only player inside the top 10 in the league in rebounding (10th, 7.9 rpg), steals (8th, 1.4 spg) and blocks (4th, 2.1 bpg), while also providing a career-best 10.1 points per game at the second-best field goal rate in the Pac-12 (.630).

### **PAC-12 MOST IMPROVED PLAYER OF THE YEAR: CHIMEZIE METU, USC**

METU joins 2010 honoree Nikola Vucevic as USC players to be named Pac-12 Most Improved Player, which has been awarded every year since 2009. He more than doubled his scoring (6.4 ppg to 14.4 ppg) and rebounding (3.6 rpg to 7.6 rpg) production compared to his freshman campaign in 2015-16, while also providing a team-best 1.4 blocks per game for the Trojans, who reached 10 Conference wins for the first time since 2011.

### **PAC-12 JOHN R. WOODEN COACH OF THE YEAR: SEAN MILLER, ARIZONA**

MILLER earns Pac-12 Coach of the Year for the third time in his eight seasons in the Conference, joining Lute Olson (seven), Mike Montgomery (four), Dana Altman (three), George Raveling (three) and Lorenzo Romar (three) as mentors with three-or-more Pac-12 Coach of the Year awards. He guided a short-handed and freshman-laden Arizona lineup to an 11-2 non-conference mark, then went 16-2 in league play to earn a share of the Pac-12 regular-season crown, the 15th in Wildcats' program history and fourth of his tenure.

Along the way, he became only the 21st coach in league history to reach 100 career Conference victories. His .743 winning percentage in league games (107-37) is third only to legends Wooden (.810) and Olson (.764) among those to reach 100 wins.

**THE VOTE:** Coach of the Year, All-Conference, All-Freshman, All-Defensive teams and Most Improved Player are voted on by the coaches. Coaches are not permitted to vote for themselves or their own players for the honors.
