#PAC12HOOPS STARTING FIVE

1 UTAH carries the postseason banner for the Pac-12 into the NIT semifinals at Madison Square Garden in New York City.
 ► Utah is making its fourth-ever trip (1947, 1974, 1992, 2018) to New York City for the NIT semifinals in its 14th all-time appearance in the postseason tournament. It is Utah's ninth all-time trip to New York City when including all rounds of the NIT. Utah also was runner-up in 1974 and third in 1992.
 ► The Utes will be aiming for their second NIT title. Utah won the national title in 1947, defeating Duquesne (45-44), West Virginia (64-62) and Kentucky (49-45) in the eight-team tournament then considered to be the collegiate national championship.

5 Five Pac-12 teams earned bids to the 2018 National Invitation Tournament, the most-ever for the Conference.
 ► The five NIT bids are the most from any conference since 2009-10.

7 Seven Pac-12 teams reached the 20-win plateau in 2017-18, equaling the most-ever 20-win teams in Conference history.
 ► The Conference also had seven 20-win teams in 2009, 2012 and 2014.

8 The Pac-12's eight combined NCAA Tournament and NIT bids matched the most-ever for the Conference.
 ► The Conference also sent eight combined members to the NCAA and NIT in 2008 (6 NCAA/2 NIT), 2013 (5 NCAA/3 NIT), 2014 (6 NCAA/2 NIT) and 2016 (7 NCAA/1 NIT).

18 UTAH's trip to MSG for the NIT semifinals marks the 18th all-time semifinal appearance for current Pac-12 Conference members.
 ► It marks the sixth semifinal trip for a Pac-12 program in the past eight seasons.

UTES' HISTORY AT MSG: Utah carries an all-time record of 19-21 in Madison Square Garden, including 10-7 in NIT games dating back to 1944.

► UTAH's most recent contest in Madison Square Garden came on Dec. 19, 2015 as the Utes upset No. 7 ranked Duke, 77-75, in overtime.

PAC-12 HISTORY AT MSG: Current Pac-12 members boast a combined 86-92 all-time record at all Madison Square Garden venues, dating to a CALIFORNIA visit to face NYU in Dec. 1935.

PAC-12 IN THE POSTSEASON NIT

The Pac-12 has had considerable success in the National Invitation Tournament (NIT), as five current members have captured the NIT crown - Colorado (1940), Utah (1947), UCLA (1985), Stanford (1991, 2012, 2015) and California (1999). Colorado also finished second in 1938 and 1991, as did Utah in 1974. Meanwhile third-place finishes were turned in by Oregon in 1975 and 2004, Colorado in 2011, Utah in 1992, Washington in 2012 and Washington State in 2011. The league now stands at 105-88 (.544) in America's original postseason tourney. The records of all Pac-12 members in the NIT:

ALL-AMERICAN AYTON: ARIZONA's **Deandre Ayton** has been named a Consensus First Team All-American (USBWA, Sporting News and NABC). He's also among the finalists for the Wooden Award, Naismith Trophy and Karl Malone Award.

► It marks the fifth consecutive year that a Pac-12 player earned Consensus First- or Second-Team All-America honors. Only the ACC matches that streak.

BIGS LOVE: The 24 double-doubles posted by ARIZONA freshman **Deandre Ayton** are tied for most nationally and most by a freshman.

► Ayton broke the league's freshman record of 23 by UCLA's Kevin Love (2007-08).

HOLIDAY SEASON: UCLA's **Aaron Holiday** (20.3p/5.8a), a Third Team All-American by Sporting News, became only the sixth player in Conference history to average 20.0+ points and 5.0+ assists for a season:

2018 PAC-12 TOURNAMENT

Deandre Ayton provided some of the most dominant performances in event history en route to being named Most Outstanding Player in leading No. 15 Arizona to its second consecutive and league-record seventh all-time Pac-12 Tournament title.

Ayton averaged 24.7 points and 12.7 rebounds in three tournament games, including 32.0 points and 16.0 rebounds in the semifinals and final, to help the Wildcats to their third tourney title in four years. His 74 total points tied for the third-most of any individual in tournament history, while his 38 rebounds were the second most.

The event's second year in Las Vegas' new T-Mobile Arena saw the fourth-highest total attendance (80,550) in event history and just the fourth time breaking 80,000 fans in 21 stagings of the tournament.

PAC-12 MOMENTUM

► The past three seasons of Pac-12 men's basketball have seen the Conference reestablish itself as one of the premier leagues in the NCAA:

► 2017-18:

- The Pac-12 sent eight teams to the postseason (3 NCAA, 5 NIT), equaling the most-ever members to earn postseason berths. The five NIT bids were the most-ever for the Conference.
- Nine teams currently rank in the NCAA RPI Top 100, which would equal the most in Conference history.

► 2016-17:

- Oregon reached the NCAA Final Four, the first Pac-12 school to advance to national semifinals since 2008.
- Pac-12 posted a 10-4 record in NCAA Tournament play, its most tourney wins since 2007 and the third-most of any league (ACC & SEC - 11).
- A Pac-12 program advanced to the Elite Eight for the fourth straight year, the only league to accomplish that feat.
- A national-best three teams (Arizona, Oregon, UCLA) finished in the top 10 of the AP and Coaches polls.
- Four Associated Press All-Americans, the most of any conference in the country and tied for most in league history (1975).
- League record and national-best 14 selections in the NBA Draft, including Nos. 1 & 2 overall picks in Markelle Fultz and Lonzo Ball. Fultz was the league's first No. 1 pick since Bill Walton in 1974.

► 2015-16:

- A league-record seven teams earned NCAA Tournament bids.
- Four teams ranked in the final Associated Press Top 25 poll, the most for the league since 2007.
- Nine teams finished season in top 100 of NCAA RPI, the most in Conference history.

► Pac-12 men's basketball enjoyed a historic 2017 NBA Draft as a league-record 14 former standouts were selected, including six in the first round highlighted by the Nos. 1 and 2 overall selections and three lottery picks.

► Over the last five NBA Drafts (2013-17), the Pac-12 has produced 42 picks overall and 23 first round selections, totals that are second only to the ACC (52, 30).

► WASHINGTON's Markelle Fultz was the No. 1 overall selection by the 76ers, joining UCLA's Bill Walton in 1974 and Lew Alcindor (Kareem Abdul-Jabbar) in 1969 as top picks from Conference members.

► WASHINGTON became the first school and the Pac-12 became the first conference to have both No. 1 NBA and WNBA Draft picks as UW's Kelsey Plum was the first choice of the San Antonio Stars in April's WNBA Draft.

► UCLA's Lonzo Ball was chosen No. 2 by the Los Angeles Lakers, marking the first time in league history and just the fourth time in the NBA Draft's 71-year history that the top two picks came from the same conference.



► Pac-12 members were well represented by alumni and former players during the 2017 NBA Playoffs with 32 players (2nd only to ACC's 41) on 13 playoff teams. Every Pac-12 program was represented in the NBA Playoffs, the only league to accomplish that feat.

► For the second straight year, the Pac-12 also led the way in the NBA Finals between the Cleveland Cavaliers and champion Golden State Warriors.

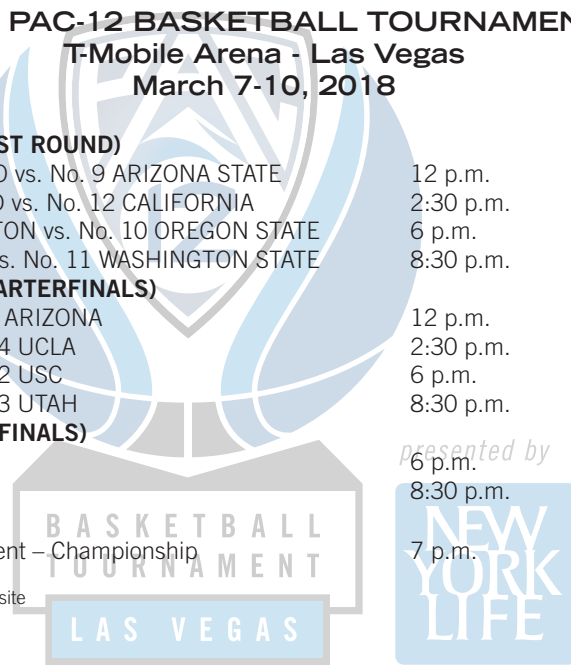

PAC-12 TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE-SEEDING & TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES

Seeding: The seedings and pairings shall be determined upon completion of regular season play on Saturday, March 3. The won-lost percentage record of the teams in regular season Conference play will determine tournament seedings. The team with the best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #1, the next best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #2, and so forth through all the seeds.

Tie-Breakers: Tie breaking procedures for determining all tournament seeding will be:

1. Two-team tie

- Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
- Each team's record (won-lost percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular standings, and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (won-lost percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

- Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
- Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.

2. Multiple-team tie

- Results (won-lost percentage) of collective head-to-head competition during the regular season among the tied teams.
- If more than two teams are still tied, each of the tied team's record (won-lost percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings, eliminating teams with inferior records, until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (won-lost percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

After one team has an advantage and is seeded, all remaining teams in the multiple-team tie-breaker will repeat the multiple-team tie-breaking procedure.

If at any point the multiple-team tie is reduced to two teams, the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

- Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
- Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.
