Pac-12 road teams went 44-64 (.407) through 108 regular-season league games.

► That eclipsed the Conference's previous best road win percentage in the Pac-12 era of .398 (43-65) in 2012-13.

1 vs. 2?

The Pac-12 Tournament Championship has featured the No. 1 and No. 2 seeds in each of the last five seasons.

► The No. 1 seed has reached the title game every year since the event moved to Las Vegas in 2013.

Over 21 prior Pac-12 Tournaments, there have been 50 upsets - victories by lower seeded teams - in 194 total games.

► Over the past four Pac-12 Tournaments, there have been just six upsets in 44 total games (2 in 2015, 2017 & 2018; zero in 2016).

► Since the event moved to Las Vegas in 2013, there have been just 13 upsets in 66 total games.

WASHINGTON's **Matisse Thybulle**, among 10 semifinalists for Naismith Trophy Defensive Player of the Year, has 315 career steals, the most of any active player in NCAA Division I and second-most in Pac-12 history.

► At 3.55 spg, Thybulle would need two more games to reach Gary Payton's all-time Pac-12 Conference mark and NCAA Division I's 26th-best total of 321.

► Thybulle also has 110 steals this season, which is tied for the most in a season in Conference history with California's Jason Kidd in 1992-93.

► Thybulle is the only D-I player in the top 50 nationally in both steals (1st, 3.55) and blocks (18th, 2.32).

► Since 1992-93, Thybulle is the only NCAA Division I player with multiple 100-steal/40-block seasons and the only player with 300+ steals and 150+ blocks in a career.

Tyler Bey, COLORADO

- Recorded back-to-back double-doubles to push season total to a league-high tying 14 to lead Colorado to victories over UCLA (93-68) and USC (78-67). Five consecutive double-doubles is the longest streak for a CU player since 1990-91.

- Averaged 22.0 points on 61 percent shooting (20-33 FG), 12.0 rebounds and 1.5 blocks.

PAC-12 TIPOFF

MORE HUSKIES HISTORY:

Regular season champion WASHINGTON made history in the post-season awards, becoming the first team to sweep the Player, Defensive Player and Coach of the Year awards in the same season.

► **Matisse Thybulle** became just the second player to repeat as the league's Defensive Player of the Year along with OREGON STATE's Gary Payton II (2015, 2016).

► **Mike Hopkins** became the first coach in Conference history to garner Coach of the Year honors in each of his first two seasons with a program.

A SUNNY RESUME: Through March 11 games, ARIZONA STATE boasts a total of 11 Quadrant 1 and Quadrant 2 wins, tied for the 21st-most in the country.

► The Sun Devils' .688 win percentage (11-5) in Q1/Q2 games is the best among teams widely considered to be on the bubble.

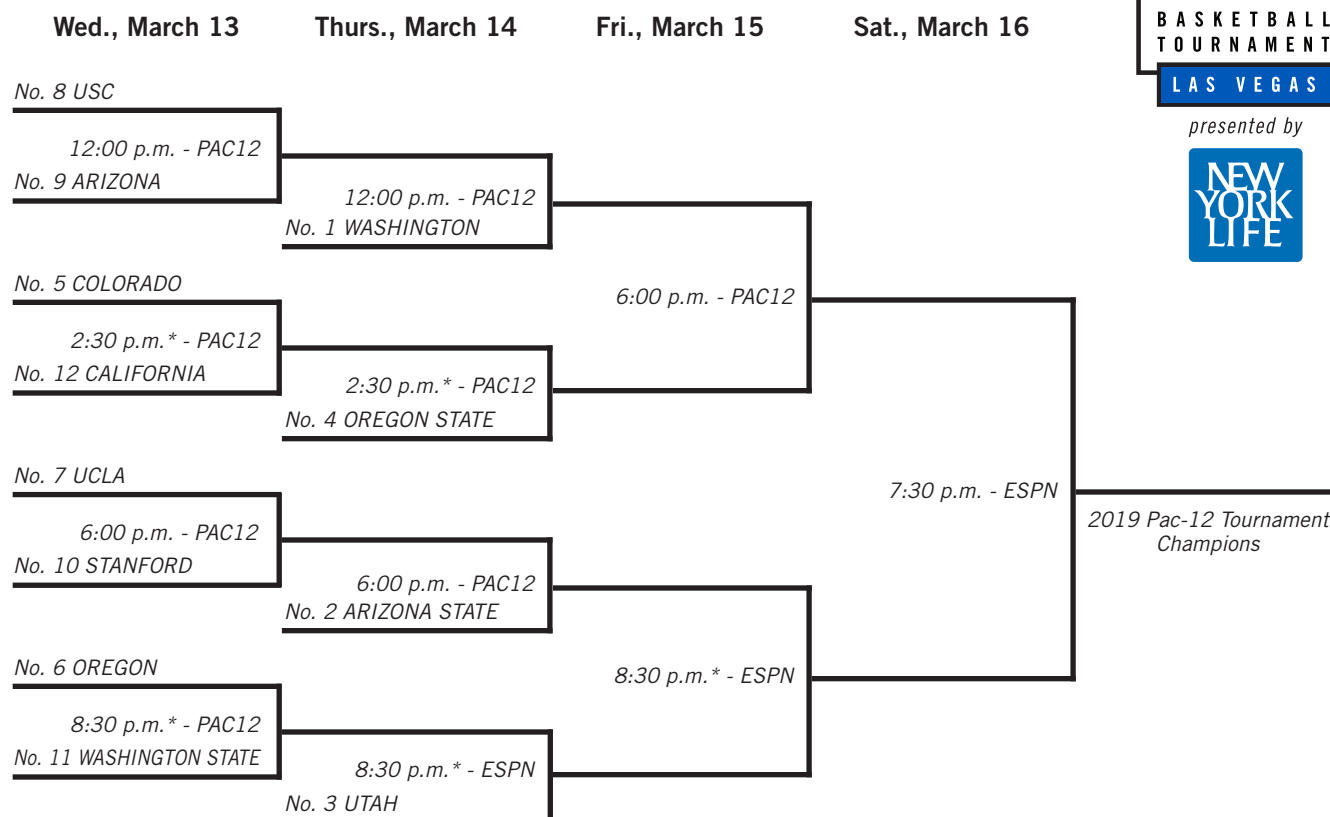

PAC-12 MOMENTUM

Pac-12 men's basketball has experienced some of its most competitive campaigns over the past several years, marked by consistent regular-season and postseason depth, and top-flight talent and recruiting:

► 2018-19:

- The Pac-12 boasted some of the best incoming talent in Division I basketball, including eight top 40 recruiting classes featuring 10 freshmen rated as Top 50 recruits and 19 Top 100 newcomers, both second-best nationally.

► 2017-18:

- The Pac-12 had seven programs reach the 20-win plateau in 2017-18, equaling the most in league history.
- The Pac-12 sent a Conference-record tying eight teams to the postseason (three NCAA, five NIT) for the fourth time in the past six seasons.
- The Pac-12 had a Conference-record nine teams finish in the RPI top 100, the second time in the past three seasons the league accomplished the feat.
- The Pac-12 produced a consensus All-American (Arizona's Deandre Ayton) for the fifth consecutive season, a feat matched only by the ACC. Ayton went on to become the league's second straight No. 1 overall NBA Draft selection.

► 2016-17:

- Oregon reached the NCAA Final Four, the first Pac-12 school to advance to national semifinals since 2008.
- Pac-12 posted a 10-4 record in NCAA Tournament play, its most tourney wins since 2007 and the third-most of any league (ACC & SEC - 11).
- A Pac-12 program advanced to the Elite Eight for the fourth straight year.
- A national-best three teams (Arizona, Oregon, UCLA) finished in the top 10 of the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today Coaches polls.
- Four Associated Press All-Americans, the most of any conference in the country and tied for most in league history (1975).
- League record and national-best 14 selections in the NBA Draft, including Nos. 1 & 2 overall picks in Markelle Fultz and Lonzo Ball. Fultz was the league's first No. 1 pick since Bill Walton in 1974.

► 2015-16:

- A league-record seven teams earned NCAA Tournament bids.
- Four teams ranked in the final Associated Press Top 25 poll, the most for the league since 2007.
- Nine teams finished season in top 100 of NCAA RPI, the most in Conference history.

► Seven former Pac-12 men's basketball standouts were selected in the 2018 NBA Draft, including the No. 1 overall selection in ARIZONA's Deandre Ayton. It marked the first time in Conference history the league has had the No. 1 pick in the NBA Draft in back-to-back years.

Ayton was the No. 1 overall selection by the Phoenix Suns, joining WASHINGTON's Markelle Fultz in 2018 and UCLA's Bill Walton in 1974 and Lew Alcindor (Kareem Abdul-Jabbar) in 1969 as top picks from Conference members. UTAH's Andrew Bogut (2005) and Bill McGill (1962) were No. 1 picks prior to the Utes joining the Pac-12.

► The seven selections coupled with the 14 picks from last year's Draft matched the league's two-year record total of 21 set in 2008-09.

► Over the past six Drafts, the Pac-12 has amassed 49 picks overall and 26 first-round selections, totals which rank second nationally behind the 15-team ACC (62, 36).



► Pac-12 members were well represented by alumni and former players during the 2018 NBA Playoffs with 37 players (2nd only to ACC's 42) on 13 playoff teams and representing 11-of-12 league programs.

► The 2018 NBA Eastern and Western Conference Finals series between Cleveland and Boston, and Golden State and Houston, featured 12 former Pac-12 standouts, the most of any league.

► For the third straight year, the Pac-12 also led the way in the NBA Finals between the Cleveland Cavaliers and champion Golden State Warriors.

PAC-12 TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE-SEEDING & TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES

Seeding: The seedings and pairings shall be determined upon completion of regular season play on Saturday, March 9. The won-lost percentage record of the teams in regular season Conference play will determine tournament seedings. The team with the best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #1, the next best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #2, and so forth through all the seeds.

Tie-Breakers: Tie breaking procedures for determining all tournament seeding will be:

1. Two-team tie

- Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
- Each team's record (won-lost percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular standings, and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (won-lost percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

- Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
- Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.

2. Multiple-team tie

- Results (won-lost percentage) of collective head-to-head competition during the regular season among the tied teams.

- If more than two teams are still tied, each of the tied team's record (won-lost percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings, eliminating teams with inferior records, until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (won-lost percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

If at any point the multiple-team tie is reduced to two teams, the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

- Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
- Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.
