PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL OPENS NEW YEAR WITH SIX TEAMS IN AP POLL

• Six Pac-12 teams are ranked in this week's *Associated Press* top 25. It is the second time during the regular season half of Pac-12 teams are ranked and the third time overall (including the preseason poll). OREGON leads the way at No. 9, also earning the same ranking in the *USA Today/WBCA* Coaches poll.

• This week's televised matchups include No. 14/14 UCLA hosting the Ducks and No. 16/16 OREGON STATE, while No. 25 ARIZONA STATE hosts a couple of tough matchups in No. 23 CALIFORNIA and No. 24 STANFORD. ASU makes its first appearance in the AP top 25 since the preseason poll and the Cardinal are back in after falling out last week, ending a streak of 17 years.

• Nearly every game this week will be televised, including every Friday clash on Pac-12 Networks. Three more Pac-12 Networks broadcasts are slated for Sunday, while the Sun Devils and Cardinal tilt will be televised on ESPN2. ASU is one of two league teams undefeated at home this season, going 7-0 on its floor so far.

• OSU is riding an eight-game win streak, the longest active streak in the Conference. The Beavs are having a strong season on both sides of the ball, leading the nation in 3-point shooting (42.7), while also limiting opponents to just 31.2 shooting from the floor, second-lowest in the nation.

• Oregon's Sabrina Ionescu broke the NCAA's triple-double record with the eighth of her career in just 48 career games. The sophomore leads the nation with four this season. She was voted the Pac-12 Player of the Week for the fifth time.

• Duck teammate Satou Sabally was tabbed the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week for the third time this season, helping UO to a 2-0 league start.

• Stanford's Brittany McPhee was named the ESPNW Player of the Week after averaging 23.5 points, 7.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game over the LA schools, to lead the Cardinal to a 2-0 start. It was McPhee's second and third games back in action after missing play due to an injury.

• UCLA's Jordin Canada is on pace to become the first player in Conference history to get 1,700 points and 700 assists. She is one of just four in league history to record 1,700 points and 600 assists. The All-American candidate ranks fifth all-time in assists in Pac-12 history.

2018 PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

KEYARENA, SEATTLE, WASH. • THURSDAY-SUNDAY, MARCH 1-4



After drawing a record attendances the last two seasons, the 17th-annual Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament remains in Seattle in partnership with Force 10 Sports Marketing, LLC, the Seattle Sports Commission and Seattle Center. The tournament will be held at KeyArena from March 1-4, 2018 and will receive unprecedented national television coverage once again with each game of the tournament scheduled to be televised either on the Pac-12 Networks or ESPN2.

The City of Seattle has embraced women's basketball and women's athletics. The WNBA's Seattle Storm loyal fan base has increased over the last several years. The majestic city provides convenient travel for teams and fans, with non-stop flights available from every Pac-12 city. In the three years the Pac-12 Tournament has been in the Emerald City, the four-day event has seen its biggest successes, recording three of the top four attendances in the 14-year history. The 2017 tournament set a record for total attendance and had the event's first sold-out session.

The Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament made its debut in 2002 and was held on the University of Oregon campus in Eugene, Ore. The Conference's premier women's sporting event then moved to HP Pavilion at San Jose for a six-year run (2003-08). It spent four years (2008-2012) in Los Angeles, with Galen Center playing host. The final two-year run of the event saw it combined with the men's tournament and the semifinal and championship games were played at the STAPLES Center.

The winner of the 12-team tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. The tournament seeding and Conference Champion are determined by the 18-game regular-season Pac-12 schedule.

CONFERENCE NOTEBOOK

RECORDS WATCH

With her fourth triple-double of the season and just 48 games into her career, OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu broke the NCAA's all-time triple-doubles career mark. At the pace she's going, Ionescu is generating a triple-double very six games, much better than the rate by previous NCAA record holders Suzie McConnell of Penn State (seven for her career at a rate of just over 18 games) and Saint Mary's Louella Tomlinson (seven for a career rate of just under 18 games).

Ionescu broke the Pac-12 record set by Stanford's Nicole Powell from 2001-04 when she had six.

PAC-12 IN THE RPI

After the first week of league play, seven Pac-12 teams have RPI in the top 50, including five in the top 30, as of Jan. 2. Leading the way is OREGON with a RPI of No. 10. UCLA (No. 16) and CALIFORNIA (No. 18) are also in the top 20.

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

Three Pac-12 teams went undefeated at home during the non-conference skate, including ARIZONA STATE (7-0), OREGON (8-0) and UTAH (7-0) and all but three teams had no more than one setback on its home floor. League teams went 58-13 (.817) at home during the non-conference.

After the first weekend of league play, the Ducks (10-0) and Sun Devils (7-0) remain unbeaten on their home floor.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS

UCLA's Jordin Canada became the 38th player in league history to hit 1,700 points against Fordham in New York. She currently ranks 37th all-time in career points. Canada also ranks fifth all-time in Pac-12 history in career assists. Canada is one of just four players in Pac-12 history to record 1,700 points and 600 assists in a career. The others are Sydney Wiese, OSU (1,824/625), Giuliana Mendiola, UW (1,928/612) and Nikki Blue, UCLA (1,797/602). Canada is on pace to become the first player in Conference history to get to 1700 pts and 700 assists. She also ranks seventh in Pac-12 history with 283 steals.

Teammate Monique Billings entered the top 25 in Pac-12 history in career rebounds and her 942 rebounds put her 23rd all-time. CALIFORNIA's Kristine Anigwe entered the league's scoring lists, becoming the 65th player in Pac-12 history to score 1,500 points.

NCAA STATS LEADERS

In the NCAA's latest statistical rankings, OREGON STATE leads the nation in three-point field-goal percentage (42.7) and ARIZONA STATE's Reili Richardson is the nation's assist-to-turnover leader at 4.69.

Although known for its defensive presence, OSU has been having a stellar offensive season so far. In addition to being the top three-point shooting team in the nation, the Beavers are third in field goal shooting (50.9). And despite having to replace an All-American guard in Sydney Wiese, OSU is third the country in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.63) while boasting an offense that ranks fourth in the nation (89.2 ppg) and scoring margin (+27.4). Defensively, the Beavs are still one of the best in the country ranking ninth in scoring defense (53.7) and second in defensive shooting percentage (31.2). Leading the way for her team from three-point range is Aleah Goodman who is second in the nation in three-point shooting (52.3).

Five Pac-12 players are ranked in the top 16 in the country in assist-to-turnover ratio. Behind Richardson, UTAH's Erika Bean is sixth (3.84), UCLA's Jordin Canada is ninth (3.44), OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu is 15th (2.95) and ASU's Kiara Russell is 16th (2.94).

CENTURY MARK

On the opening day of the season, UCLA scored a school-record 129 points to defeat San Jose State (69) at home. That point total broke a school record and was just a bucket shy of the Pac-12 mark (131, Oregon vs. CS Bakersfield, Nov. 9, 2013). It was the most points scored by a league team since Oregon dropped 130 vs. Southern on Dec. 18, 2013.

NCAA ACTIVE LEADERS

Four Pac-12 players can be found among the NCAA's active career leaders (as of Jan. 2). UCLA's Jordin Canada has proven herself to be one of the top point guards in the nation. She currently ranks second in career assists (669) among active players becoming just the 10th player in Conference history to dish out 600 assists. She is also third among active leaders with 285 steals.

Bruin teammate Monique Billings' 942 career rebounds ranks sixth among the active players in the nation. CALIFORNIA's Kristine Anigwe currently has the fourth-best career scoring average among players in the country at 20.1 points per game, while OREGON's Lexi Bando's 45.6 career three-point percentage is the best among active players.

TRIPLE DOUBLES GALORE

The NCAA's new triple-double record holder OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu and UCLA's Jordin Canada opened the 2017-18 campaign with a triple-double each and since, have combined for five, giving the Conference 34 instances all-time. Since the start of the 2015-16 campaign, there have been a total of 12 triple-doubles achieved.

Triple-doubles were a rare occurrence in the Pac-12 prior to the 2012-13 campaign. From Feb. 1996-Feb. 4, 2012, only two players had achieved the feat with former Stanford standout Nicole Powell accounting for six instances from Feb. 2001-Mar. 2002 and former UCLA great Noelle Quinn had one triple-double to her credit in Feb. 2004. Since Feb. 2012, there has been at least one triple-double each year.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

Pac-12 teams collectively went 98-39 during the non-conference regular-season slate. It is the third-straight year the Conference posted a .700 or better winning percentage, going .715. 11 league teams

posted at least a .500 record during the non-league slate, marking the fourth-straight year at least 11 teams have done so.

HISTORIC CAMPAIGN

Pac-12 women's basketball is coming off back-to-back historic seasons, sending two teams to the NCAA Women's Final Four for the first time ever in 2015-16 and following up with a Conference-record seven teams earning NCAA Tournament bids. At least one Pac-12 team has reached the national semifinal round in nine of the last 10 years. League teams have not lost in the first round of the NCAA Tournament the last two years, combining for a 12-0 record. Additionally, the Conference has set records for the number of league teams advancing to the Sweet Sixteen and Elite Eight, with a combined nine teams reaching the round of 16. The Pac-12 has also boasted the top conference RPI in the country the last two seasons.

In addition to the overall success of league teams last year, it was a special campaign following Washington's Kelsey Plum break the all-time NCAA scoring record and celebrating Stanford's Tara VanDerveer's 1,000th-career win, a feat only one other Division women's basketball head coach had achieved and only two men's or women's Division I head coach.

ALL-STAR RETURNS

Nine of the 15 All-Pac-12 honorees return this season, including four of the Conference's top-five scorers and three of the top-five rebounders. UCLA's Monique Billings was one of just two players last season to average a double-double, ranking fifth in scoring (16.7) and second in rebounding (10.5). The last two US-BWA National Freshmen of the Year are among the all-star returnees, with CALIFORNIA's Kristine Anigwe earning the honor in 2016 and OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu picking up the award in 2017. The Pac-12's assist and assist-to-turnover leader UCLA's Jordin Canada also returns.

Other All-Pac-12 honorees on team rosters this season are Oregon's Ruthy Hebard, Oregon State's Marie Gulich, Colorado's Kennedy Leonard, Stanford's Brittany McPhee and USC's Kristen Simon.

NEW FACES & FAMILIAR FACES

The Pac-12 welcomes a pair of new coaches to the sidelines this season. USC's Mark Trakh returns for his second stint as head coach of the Trojans. He spent 2005-2009 in Los Angeles, leading USC to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. Most recently, he was coach at New Mexico State where the team earned three-consecutive NCAA Tournament berths. Jody Wynn takes over at Washington after spending the last eight years as head coach at Long Beach State where she led the team to three-consecutive 20-win campaigns and a NCAA Tournament berth.

ROAD TO COLUMBUS

Teams across the country will be focused on getting to Columbus this season, the site of the 2018 NCAA Women's Final Four. To get to Columbus, Ohio, teams will have to go through regional sites at Lexington, Ky., Albany, N.Y., Kansas City, Mo., and Spokane, Wash. The first and second round of the tournament will take place on 16 campus sites with the top-16 seeds hosting.
