## KEY MATCHUPS HEADLINE PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL SLATE

For the second-straight week, key matchups highlight the Pac-12 women's basketball slate, including a pair of top-20 clashes on Pac-12 Network. No. 8 UCLA puts its 29-game home win streak on the line when No. 3 Baylor visits Pauley Pavilion. Both teams have the ability to put up big numbers, each averaging over 100 points per game after the opening weekend ... On Sunday, No. 18 OREGON STATE hosts No. 6 Notre Dame. The Pac-12 leader in scoring defense last year, the Beavers will have to tame the UND offense that scored 121 points in its season-opener ... No. 10 OREGON is in the semifinal of the Preseason WNIT. The Ducks travel to No. 19 Texas A&M to play for a spot in the championship game on Sunday. Pac-12 Player of the Week Sabrina Ionescu is eyeing the Conference's triple-doubles career record after posting her fifth in her short career last week. Her teammate Satou Sabally was named the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week ... No. 20 CALIFORNIA also hits the road for a tough matchup, facing No. 1 Connecticut on Friday ... The first of the national player of the year award watch lists was released and six from the Pac-12 were among the 30 candidates for the John R. Wooden Award: Cal's Kristine Anigwe, UCLA's Monique Billings and Jordin Canada, Oregon's Ruthy Hebard and Ionescu, and Stanford's Brittany McPhee ... Five Pac-12 teams are ranked in this week's *Associated Press* poll with two teams in the top 10 and three in the top 15. STANFORD is coming in at No. 14 and ARIZONA STATE is receiving votes ... The Cardinal's home opener vs. UC Riverside will also be televised on Pac-12 Network.

# 2018 PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT KEYARENA, SEATTLE, WASH. • THURSDAY-SUNDAY, MARCH 1-4



After drawing a record attendances the last two seasons, the 17th-annual Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament remains in Seattle in partnership with Force 10 Sports Marketing, LLC, the Seattle Sports Commission and Seattle Center. The tournament will be held at KeyArena from March 1-4, 2018 and will receive unprecedented national television coverage once again with each game of the tournament scheduled to be televised either on the Pac-12 Networks or ESPN2.

The City of Seattle has embraced women's basketball and women's athletics. The WNBA's Seattle Storm loyal fan base has increased over the last several years. The majestic city provides convenient travel for teams and fans, with non-stop flights available from every Pac-12 city. In the three years the Pac-12 Tournament has been in the Emerald City, the four-day event has seen its biggest successes, recording three of the top four attendances in the 14-year history. The 2017 tournament set a record for total attendance and had the event's first sold-out session.

The Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament made its debut in 2002 and was held on the University of Oregon campus in Eugene, Ore. The Conference's premier women's sporting event then moved to HP Pavilion at San Jose for a six-year run (2003-08). It spent four years (2008-2012) in Los Angeles, with Galen Center playing host. The final two-year run of the event saw it combined with the men's tournament and the semifinal and championship games were played at the STAPLES Center.

The winner of the 12-team tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. The tournament seeding and Conference Champion are determined by the 18-game regular-season Pac-12 schedule.

## CONFERENCE NOTEBOOK

### RECORDS WATCH

Picking up where Pac-12 women's basketball left off last year with chasing down records. OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu kicked off the 2017-18 campaign posting a triple-double. Just one game into her sophomore campaign, she has five triple-doubles to her credit, one away from the Pac-12 career record and two from the NCAA record.

### NCAA ACTIVE LEADERS

Four Pac-12 players can be found among the NCAA's active career leaders. UCLA's Jordin Canada has proven herself to be one of the top point guards in the nation. She currently ranks second in career assists (594) among active players. She is also looking to become just the 10th player in Conference history to dish out 600 assists. She is also fourth among active leaders with 246 steals.

Teammate Monique Billings is fourth among current players in the country with 843 players. CALIFORNIA's Kristine Anigwe currently has the third-best career scoring average among players in the country at 20.7 points per game, while OREGON's Lexi Bando's 46.0 career three-point percentage is second-best in the nation.

### TRIPLE DOUBLES GALORE

OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu, who is chasing the NCAA and Pac-12 records, and UCLA's Jordin Canada have started the season with a triple-double each, giving the Conference 31 instances all-time. Since the start of last season, there have been a total of nine triple-doubles achieved.

Triple-doubles were a rare occurrence in the Pac-12 prior to the 2012-13 campaign. From Feb. 1996-Feb. 4, 2012, only two players had achieved the feat with former Stanford standout Nicole Powell accounting for six instances from Feb. 2001-Mar. 2002 and former UCLA great Noelle Quinn had one triple-double to her credit in Feb. 2004. Since Feb. 2012, there has been at least one triple-double each year.

### HISTORIC CAMPAIGN

Pac-12 women's basketball is coming off back-to-back historic seasons, sending two teams to the NCAA Women's Final Four for the first time ever in 2015-16 and following up with a Conference-record seven teams earning NCAA Tournament bids. At least one Pac-12 team has reached the national semifinal round in nine of the last 10 years. League teams have not lost in the first round of the NCAA Tournament the last two years, combining for a 12-0 record. Additionally, the Conference has set records for the number of league teams advancing to the Sweet Sixteen and Elite Eight, with a combined nine teams reaching the round of 16. The Pac-12 has also boasted the top conference RPI in the country the last two seasons.

In addition to the overall success of league teams last year, it was a special campaign following Washington's Kelsey Plum break the all-time NCAA scoring record and celebrating Stanford's Tara VanDerveer's 1,000th-career win, a feat only one other Division women's basketball head coach had achieved and only two men's or women's Division I head coach.

### ALL-STAR RETURNS

Nine of the 15 All-Pac-12 honorees return this season, including four of the Conference's top-five scorers and three of the top-five rebounders. UCLA's Monique Billings was one of just two players last season to average a double-double, ranking fifth in scoring (16.7) and second in rebounding (10.5). The last two US-BWA National Freshmen of the Year are among the all-star returnees, with CALIFORNIA's Kristine Anigwe earning the honor in 2016 and OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu picking up the award in 2017. The Pac-12's assist and assist-to-turnover leader UCLA's Jordin Canada also returns.

Other All-Pac-12 honorees on team rosters this season are Oregon's Ruthy Hebard, Oregon State's Marie Gulich, Colorado's Kennedy Leonard, Stanford's Brittney McPhee and USC's Kristen Simon.

### NEW FACES & FAMILIAR FACES

The Pac-12 welcomes a pair of new coaches to the sidelines this season. USC's Mark Trakh returns for his second stint as head coach of the Trojans. He spent 2005-2009 in Los Angeles, leading USC to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. Most recently, he was coach at New Mexico State where the team earned three-consecutive NCAA Tournament berths. Jody Wynn takes over at Washington after spending the last eight years as head coach at Long Beach State where she led the team to three-consecutive 20-win campaigns and a NCAA Tournament berth.

### ROAD TO COLUMBUS

Teams across the country will be focused on getting to Columbus this season, the site of the 2018 NCAA Women's Final Four. To get to Columbus, Ohio, teams will have to go through regional sites at Lexington, Ky., Albany, N.Y., Kansas City, Mo., and Spokane, Wash. The first and second round of the tournament will take place on 16 campus sites with the top-16 seeds hosting.
