## THIS WEEK IN PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

No. 7 UCLA and No. 10 OREGON lead five Pac-12 women's basketball teams in the latest *Associated Press* poll. At least five teams have been in the writers' top 25 for the fourth-consecutive week. Four teams are in the *USA Today*/WBCA Coaches poll, the Bruins and the Ducks owning a No. 7 and No. 10 ranking, as well. The AP tabbed STANFORD No. 16, OREGON STATE No. 21 and CALIFORNIA No. 24. The Cardinal are No. 14 in the that poll and the Beavers are No. 19 ... USC is the only team in the Conference and one of 27 in the NCAA to remain undefeated. The Trojans' gave head coach Mark Trakh his 400th-career win last week at Hawai'i ... The candidate lists for the Naismith Award and Wade Trophy were released on Wednesday and seven from the Pac-12 appear on one or both lists. UCLA's Monique Billings and Jordin Canada, CALIFORNIA's Kristine Anigwe and OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu appear on both lists. The four are joined by the Ducks' Ruthy Hebard, OSU's Marie Gulich and Stanford's Brittany McPhee are on the Naismith Award list ... Stanford's Alanna Smith was voted the Pac-12 Player of the Week after averaging 23.7 points and 11.7 rebounds per game last week. Cal's Kianna Smith was voted the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week after a 12-assist outing last week ... Ionescu continues to threaten the NCAA's career triple-doubles record after already tying the Pac-12 record. Her next triple-double would not only break the Conference's mark that has stood since 2004, but also tie the NCAA record which was set in 1988 ... On Sunday, Stanford takes on its fourth ranking opponent, traveling to No. 9 Baylor.

# 2018 PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT KEYARENA, SEATTLE, WASH. • THURSDAY-SUNDAY, MARCH 1-4



After drawing a record attendances the last two seasons, the 17th-annual Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament remains in Seattle in partnership with Force 10 Sports Marketing, LLC, the Seattle Sports Commission and Seattle Center. The tournament will be held at KeyArena from March 1-4, 2018 and will receive unprecedented national television coverage once again with each game of the tournament scheduled to be televised either on the Pac-12 Networks or ESPN2.

The City of Seattle has embraced women's basketball and women's athletics. The WNBA's Seattle Storm loyal fan base has increased over the last several years. The majestic city provides convenient travel for teams and fans, with non-stop flights available from every Pac-12 city. In the three years the Pac-12 Tournament has been in the Emerald City, the four-day event has seen its biggest successes, recording three of the top four attendances in the 14-year history. The 2017 tournament set a record for total attendance and had the event's first sold-out session.

The Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament made its debut in 2002 and was held on the University of Oregon campus in Eugene, Ore. The Conference's premier women's sporting event then moved to HP Pavilion at San Jose for a six-year run (2003-08). It spent four years (2008-2012) in Los Angeles, with Galen Center playing host. The final two-year run of the event saw it combined with the men's tournament and the semifinal and championship games were played at the STAPLES Center.

The winner of the 12-team tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. The tournament seeding and Conference Champion are determined by the 18-game regular-season Pac-12 schedule.

3 GP, 23.7 ppg, 11.7 rpg, 31-48 (.646), 7-9 FT (.778), 4 ast, 6 blk

- Averaged a double-double with 23.7 points and 11.7 rebounds in Stanford's 2-1 week at the Play4Kay Showcase in Las Vegas.
- Shot 64.6 percent from the field (31-of-48), 40 percent from deep and averaged 2.0 blocks per game.
- Had the best performance of her career in the Cardinal's 94-82 overtime loss to No. 9 Ohio State on Saturday, setting career highs in both scoring (33) and rebounding (16).

## CONFERENCE NOTEBOOK

### RECORDS WATCH

Picking up where Pac-12 women's basketball left off last year with chasing down records, OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu kicked off the 2017-18 campaign posting a triple-double in the first game of the season and already has two. With those two occurrences, she has already tied the Pac-12 career mark and is one shy of tying the NCAA record.

### NCAA ACTIVE LEADERS

Four Pac-12 players can be found among the NCAA's active career leaders. UCLA's Jordin Canada has proven herself to be one of the top point guards in the nation. She currently ranks second in career assists (626) among active players becoming just the 10th player in Conference history to dish out 600 assists. She is also second among active leaders with 262 steals.

Bruin teammate Monique Billings' 889 career rebounds ranks third among the active players in the nation. CALIFORNIA's Kristine Anigwe currently has the third-best career scoring average among players in the country at 20.3 points per game and her 9.4 career rebounding average is fourth, while OREGON's Lexi Bando's 45.6 career three-point percentage is the top-shooting percentage in the nation.

### TRIPLE DOUBLES GALORE

OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu, who is chasing the NCAA and Pac-12 records, and UCLA's Jordin Canada opened the 2017-18 campaign with a triple-double each and since, have combined for three, giving the Conference 32 instances all-time. Since the start of the 2015-16 campaign, there have been a total of 10 triple-doubles achieved.

Triple-doubles were a rare occurrence in the Pac-12 prior to the 2012-13 campaign. From Feb. 1996-Feb. 4, 2012, only two players had achieved the feat with former Stanford standout Nicole Powell accounting for six instances from Feb. 2001-Mar. 2002 and former UCLA great Noelle Quinn had one triple-double to her credit in Feb. 2004. Since Feb. 2012, there has been at least one triple-double each year.

### HISTORIC CAMPAIGN

Pac-12 women's basketball is coming off back-to-back historic seasons, sending two teams to the NCAA Women's Final Four for the first time ever in 2015-16 and following up with a Conference-record seven teams earning NCAA Tournament bids. At least one Pac-12 team has reached the national semifinal round in nine of the last 10 years. League teams have not lost in the first round of the NCAA Tournament the last two years, combining for a 12-0 record. Additionally, the Conference has set records for the number of league teams advancing to the Sweet Sixteen and Elite Eight, with a combined nine teams reaching the round of 16. The Pac-12 has also boasted the top conference RPI in the country the last two seasons.

In addition to the overall success of league teams last year, it was a special campaign following Washington's Kelsey Plum break the all-time NCAA scoring record and celebrating Stanford's Tara VanDerveer's 1,000th-career win, a feat only one other Division women's basketball head coach had achieved and only two men's or women's Division I head coach.

### ALL-STAR RETURNS

Nine of the 15 All-Pac-12 honorees return this season, including four of the Conference's top-five scorers and three of the top-five rebounders. UCLA's Monique Billings was one of just two players last season to average a double-double, ranking fifth in scoring (16.7) and second in rebounding (10.5). The last two USBWA National Freshmen of the Year are among the all-star returnees, with CALIFORNIA's Kristine Anigwe earning the honor in 2016 and OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu picking up the award in 2017. The Pac-12's assist and assist-to-turnover leader UCLA's Jordin Canada also returns.

Other All-Pac-12 honorees on team rosters this season are Oregon's Ruthy Hebard, Oregon State's Marie Gulich, Colorado's Kennedy Leonard, Stanford's Brittany McPhee and USC's Kristen Simon.

### NEW FACES & FAMILIAR FACES

The Pac-12 welcomes a pair of new coaches to the sidelines this season. USC's Mark Trakh returns for his second stint as head coach of the Trojans. He spent 2005-2009 in Los Angeles, leading USC to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. Most recently, he was coach at New Mexico State where the team earned three-consecutive NCAA Tournament berths. Jody Wynn takes over at Washington after spending the last eight years as head coach at Long Beach State where she led the team to three-consecutive 20-win campaigns and a NCAA Tournament berth.

### ROAD TO COLUMBUS

Teams across the country will be focused on getting to Columbus this season, the site of the 2018 NCAA Women's Final Four. To get to Columbus, Ohio, teams will have to go through regional sites at Lexington, Ky., Albany, N.Y., Kansas City, Mo., and Spokane, Wash. The first and second round of the tournament will take place on 16 campus sites with the top-16 seeds hosting.
