

HERM EDWARDS - HEAD COACH

- Completed first season at Arizona State going 7-6 (5-4 Pac-12), knocking off two Top-25 teams at home, No. 15 Michigan State and No. 16 Utah
- Helped ASU finish second in the Pac-12 South, including a comeback victory against rival Arizona in the Territorial Cup game, winning 41-40 to close out the season.
- Edwards is the only first-year coach in program history to defeat USC, UCLA, and Arizona, and bring the Sun Devils to a bowl game all in one season.
- Spent 10 seasons in NFL as a cornerback with the Philadelphia Eagles, Atlanta Falcons, and Los Angeles Rams, followed by another 18 years as a scout, position coach, assistant and head coach with Kansas City Chiefs, Tampa Bay Buccaneers, and New York Jets.
- Played cornerback for California in 1972 and 1974 before ending his collegiate athletic career at San Diego State in 1975.



ENO BENJAMIN - JUNIOR RB

- Named to the 2019 Maxwell Award Watch List and Preseason All-American by Phil Steele.
- Selected to the 2019 Doak Walker Award Watch List after being named a semifinalist for the honor in 2018.
- Earned Pac-12 All-Conference First Team honors in 2018 after leading the Conference in rushing yards (1,642), rushing yards per game (126.3), rushing touchdowns (16), and carries (300).
- His 1,642 rushing yards were the fifth-most in the country and broke Arizona State's single-season record, previously held by Woody Green (1,565) in 1972.
- Ran for the third-most first downs in the country (81) and forced 94 missed tackles, also good for the third-highest mark in the nation in 2018.
- Benjamin's 300 total carries and nine 100-yard rushing games in 2018 set respective single-season school records for Arizona State.
- Broke ASU's single-game record for rushing yards in a game (312) on just 30 carries in the Sun Devils' victory over Oregon State (Sept. 9, 2018), adding three scores in the effort.



COHL CABRAL - SENIOR C

- Started in all 13 games for ASU and is the third-highest graded center in the Pac-12 as a run blocker (66.3).
- Earned Pac-12 All-Conference Second Team honors.
- Helped block for running back Eno Benjamin, who led the Pac-12 in rushing yards (1,642) and rushing touchdowns (16).
- Was one of just 15 Power Five centers to not allow a sack all season in 2018.
- Helped the Sun Devil offensive line have six games without a sack, the first such total since at least 2000.
- Was part of an offensive line that allowed only 16 sacks the entire season, the third-fewest in program history, and 14th in the FBS with 1.23 allowed per game.
