CALIFORNIA GOLDEN BEARS





JUSTIN WILCOX - HEAD COACH

- Entering his third full season as California's head coach, Wilcox owns a 12-11 overall record and 6-12 conference mark.
- Led the Golden Bears to a 3-0 record to begin 2018 non-conference play, including wins over North Carolina, BYU, and Idaho State.
- Recorded signature 15-14 victory over USC on Nov. 10, 2018, as the win sealed bowl eligibility and marked the program's first win against the Trojans since 2003.
- Guided Cal to a 2018 Cheez-It Bowl appearance against TCU, marking his first postseason appearance as head coach for Cal and 15th bowl staff on which he has coached in his career.
- Helped solidify the Cal defense as one of the Conference's best, leading the Pac-12 in interceptions (21), defensive touchdowns (five), turnovers forced (28) and passing yards allowed per game (175.1).
- Spent his previous 11 seasons as a defensive coordinator for five different schools, including two Pac-12 programs (USC, Washington) and was the Golden Bears' linebackers coach from 2003-05 in his first position as a full-time coach.
- Graduated with a B.A. in anthropology from Oregon, where he played safety and cornerback in 1996-99, named second-team All-Pac-10 and earned Pac-10 All-Academic honors in 1999.
- Father, Dave, is in the Pro Football Hall of Fame when he played linebacker for the San Francisco 49ers (1964-74). His uncle, John, and brother, Josh, also played in the NFL.



EVAN WEAVER - SENIOR LB

- Selected to the 2019 Lott IMPACT Trophy and Bednarik Award Watch Lists.
- Enters the 2019 season as California's active leader in tackles (230), tackles for loss (13.0) and sacks (6.0).
- Recorded 159 total tackles in 2018, good for the second-highest total in the nation and a tie for second on Cal's all-time single-season.
- Earned second-team All-American honors (Pro Football Focus), as well as second-team All-Pac-12 accolades in 2018.
- His 159 tackles and 12.2 tackles per game were the second-highest respective marks in the Pac-12.
- Recorded a career-high 18 tackles in Cal's win over Colorado (Nov. 24, 2018), including 2.0 tackles for loss and a sack on the day.
- Combined with Jordan Kunaszyk for 307 tackles in 2018, the most ever by a Cal duo in a single season.
- Ranked by Athlon Sports as the No. 3 linebacker and No. 37 overall player in the nation for the upcoming season.
- A native of Spokane, Wash., Weaver was a three-year starter at Gonzaga Prep, where he compiled 393 tackles, 78.0 tackles for loss, 14 forced fumbles, and eight pass deflections across his prep career.



CAMRYN BYNUM - REDSHIRT JUNIOR CB

- Earned All-Pac-12 honorable mention honors in 2018.
- Recorded a team-high 10 pass breakups as a redshirt sophomore, adding 48 tackles and a career-high two interceptions.
- Posted a career-high nine tackles against USC, adding 0.5 tackles for loss.
- Has started each of the Golden Bears' last 25 games at cornerback after redshirting his freshman season.
- Named Cal's Berkeley Breakfast Club Award winner as the Outstanding Player in the Big Game.
- Enters 2019 as Cal's active leader in passes defended (22) and pass breakups (18).
- Named preseason second-team All-Pac-12 by Athlon Sports for the upcoming season.
- Received Cal's Bob Simmons Award as the Most Valuable Freshman in 2017 after recording 58 total tackles, two interceptions, 10 passes defensed and 0.5 tackles for loss.
- Bynum joined the Golden Bears after graduating from Centennial High School in Corona, Calif. in 2016, where he compiled two-year varsity prep totals of 136 tackles, six interceptions, and two fumble recoveries.
