STANFORD CARDINAL



DAVID SHAW - HEAD COACH

- Entering his ninth season as Stanford's head coach, Shaw owns an 82-26 overall record since becoming Bradford M. Freeman Director of Football.
- Guided the Cardinal to a 9-4 overall record and 6-3 conference mark in 2018, including a 14-13 victory in the Sun Bowl against Pitt.
- Coached quarterback K.J. Costello to the second-most passing yards per game (272.3) and a tie for the second-most passing touchdowns (29) in the Pac-12.
- Guided wide receiver JJ Arcega-Whiteside to the most receiving scores (14) in the Conference in 2018, tied for the most in Stanford single-season history.
- 2017 Dodd Trophy winner as national coach of the year.
- Only four-time recipient of the Pac-12 Coach of the Year Award (2011, 2012, 2015 co-winner, 2017)
- Led Stanford to two Rose Bowl Championships following 2012 and 2015 seasons.
- Since taking over the Cardinal program in 2011, Stanford's 82 wins are the sixth-most wins in the FBS over that time.
- Has won 25 games against AP-ranked opponents, good for fourth nationally since 2011.
- Stanford's offensive coordinator under Jim Harbaugh from 2007-10.
- Played Wide Receiver at Stanford from 1991-94.
- Father, Willie Shaw, was an assistant coach in college football and the NFL from 1974-2002, including two stints at Stanford (1974-76, 1989-91).



K.J. COSTELLO - SENIOR QB

- Started all 13 games last season, compiling 3,540 passing yards and 29 touchdowns with 65.1 completion percentage to earn 2018 All-Pac-12 second team honors.
- Threw for the second-most passing yards in Stanford single-season history with 3,540, a mark good for second in the Pac-12 last season.
- Totaled at least 300 passing yards in seven contests in 2018, including a career-high 381 through the air against Utah.
- Threw for at least four touchdowns in four games in 2018, including a career-high five passing scores against UCLA in a 344-yard effort.
- Garnered Pac-12 All-Academic honorable mention accolades for the second consecutive year.
- Selected to the Maxwell Award Watch List for the second consecutive season.
- Enters 2019 on the Davey O'Brien Award Watch List.
- Appeared in 11 games and started seven as a sophomore in 2017, totaling 1,573 yards, 14 touchdowns, and four interceptions. He also tallied 92 yards and three scores on the ground.
- Named preseason All-Pac-12 Second Team by Phil Steele and Athlon Sports for the 2019 season.
- A four-year letter-winner at Santa Margarita Catholic (Calif.), Costello threw for 8,222 yards to break Carson Palmer's career school record. He also owns the school record for passing touchdowns with 62 in his career.



CASEY TOOHILL - REDSHIRT SENIOR LB

- Three-time Pac-12 All-Academic honoree, garnering first-team accolades in 2016 and 2018 for his political science major.
- Played in seven games and started five in 2018, registering career-high totals in tackles (29), tackles for loss (5.0), and sacks (3.0).
- Tallied a career-high eight tackles against USC, adding a sack and a pass breakup in the win against the Trojans.
- In Sun Bowl victory against Pitt, he registered seven tackles, 1.0 tackle for loss, and three quarterback hurries.
- In 2017, he recorded 21 tackles (10 solo) 4.0 tackles for loss, 1.0 sack, one fumble recovery, and an interception.
