

The USC Trojans captured their first Pac-12 Championship since 2011 and 20th overall with a four-stroke victory over COLORADO. USC's **Justin Suh** paced the way for the Trojans, earning medalist honors with a score of 16-under (268). The second-place showing for the Buffaloes was the highest finish for the CU program since joining the Pac-12.

Eight teams (ARIZONA, ARIZONA STATE, CALIFORNIA, COLORADO, OREGON, STANFORD, UCLA, USC) participated in the NCAA Regional Championships where the Sun Devils, Ducks, Cardinal and Bruins advanced to the NCAA Championships. Arizona State was the Pac-12's highest finisher, coming in tied for 13th.

Three individuals found themselves atop the Golfstat's scoring average rankings all season - California's **Collin Morikawa** at No. 1 (68.68), Suh at No. 2 (68.73), and Oregon's **Norman Xiong** at No. 3 (69.05). Morikawa's scoring average is the lowest ever posted in one season in NCAA history. Suh's is the second lowest, while Xiong's is tied for fourth lowest. That trio combined for 14 wins during the 2017-18 season as Morikawa picked up three victories, while Suh and Xiong posted school single-season records with five and six wins, respectively.

Suh was named the Pac-12 Men's Golfer of the Year, teammate **Kaito Onishi** was tabbed Pac-12 Freshman of the Year and California coach **Walter Chun** picked up Pac-12 Coach of the Year honors for the first time in his career.

Xiong earned a couple of postseason accolades with the Fred Haskins Award (Outstanding Golfer) and the Jack Nicklaus Award (Division I Player of the Year), while Morikawa was tabbed *Golfweek* Player of the Year. It was the sixth consecutive year a Pac-12 golfer earned *Golfweek's* honor. Xiong, Morikawa and Suh were named PING GCAA First Team All-Americans, as well as All-Nicklaus Team selections. Earning PING GCAA Second Team All-America honors was Arizona's **George Cunningham**, while Stanford's **Isaiah Salinda** collected Honorable Mention honors.
