THIS WEEK IN PAC-12 SOFTBALL

- Opening Conference play, four Pac-12 softball teams swept the weekend as No. 3/3 Oregon remains the lone undefeated team in the NCAA and No. 6/5 Washington posted the No. 1 NCAA RPI.
- The Ducks and the Huskies along with No. 11/13 Utah and No. 5/4 Arizona swept their Conference opponents this weekend. The Wildcats' **Jessie Harper** earned player and freshman of the week for her helping Arizona go 5-0 with a sweep at Oregon State. Utah's **Maria Viramontes** won two of the three games with a .64 ERA as Utah swept No. 10 UCLA in Los Angeles to earn pitcher of the week honors.
- A top five matchup between Arizona and Washington highlights the week when the Huskies travel to Tucson for a three game matchup. Oregon State heads to Arizona State, Oregon is at UCLA and rivals Stanford and California meet in Berkeley. UCLA hosts home matchups between BYU and Dartmouth to finish out the week.
- In the first NCAA RPI rankings of the year, Washington claimed the No. 1 spot with 4 Pac-12 teams in the top-10, tied for the most of any Conference. Arizona is at No. 3, Oregon is at No. 8, UCLA is at No. 10. California at No. 18 and Utah at No 20 also crack the top-25
- Oregon continues to lead the way in both the NFCA/USA Today and ESPN/USA Softball polls at No. 3. Arizona follows at No. 5/4, Washington at No. 6/5, Utah moved up at No. 11/13, UCLA is at No. 15/16, Arizona State at No. 21/24 and California received votes and is at No. 23.

PAC-12 SOFTBALL NOTES

- Washington head coach **Heather Tarr** earned her 500th career win last Friday night as the No. 8 Huskies beat No. 7 Minnesota, 3-2, in the UW's opening game of the Husky Classic. The Huskies ended the that weekend with a perfect 5-0 outing.
- Washington's **Ari Aguilar**, Utah's **Hannah Flippen**, and UCLA's **Delaney Spaulding** have been selected as candidates for the 2017 Senior CLASS Award in collegiate softball for their work both on and off the field. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition. The 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists later in the season.
- League teams outscored their opponents by more than double in the opening weekend, recording 308 runs while holding opponents to just 102. Seven of the nine league teams outscored their opponents by double digits this week: Arizona: 39-6; Arizona State: 37-7; California: 31-19; Oregon: 38-10; Oregon State: 12-3; UCLA: 48-2 ; Utah: 47-5
- According to FloSoftball, seven Pac-12 recruiting classes are ranked in the top 25 including Oregon bringing in the No. 1 recruiting class in the nation this year. Arizona has the third-ranked class, followed by Washington, UCLA and Arizona State with the No. 6, 8 and 12 classes. Utah brings in the 13th-ranked recruiting class and Stanford rounds out at No. 14.
