THIS YEAR IN PAC-12 VOLLEYBALL

- Pac-12 Champion STANFORD led nine league teams earning NCAA Tournament bids, the Cardinal making its 21st all-time NCAA semifinal appearance. It marked the 12th-consecutive year the Pac-12 had at least six teams earn tournament berths. League teams went 8-1 in the first round this season, eventually advancing five teams to the round of 16, the 18th time at least three Pac-12 teams reached the regional semifinal round.

- Six Pac-12 teams appeared in the final AVCA poll, with the Cardinal spending the entire season in the top five and finishing at No. 4. USC ended up in the top 10 at No. 7 after starting the season unranked, while UTAH received its highest final rating at No. 11. UCLA (No. 14), WASHINGTON (No. 15) and COLORADO (No. 19).

- Stanford won its 17th all-time Pac-12 crown and first under head coach Kevin Hambly, who was in his first season on the Cardinal bench. Sophomore Kathryn Plummer took home several awards, garnering national player of the year honors by the AVCA and ESPNW. Plummer is the sixth Pac-12 student-athlete to earn the AVCA honor in the last eight years, and the first Cardinal since 2007. Plummer was also tabbed the Pac-12 Player of the Year one year after being voted Pac-12 Freshman of the Year and AVCA National Freshman of the Year. She is just the second player in league history, and first since 1989, to earn Conference freshman and player of the year honors in back-to-back seasons.

- Sophomore teammates Jenna Gray and Morgan Hentz were also voted the Pac-12 Setter and Libero of the Year, respectively. Joining the list of honorees were OREGON STATE's Mark Barnard who was tabbed the Pac-12 Coach of the Year after a campaign the saw the Beavers accomplishments not seen in decades. OSU's Kylee McLaughlin was picked the Pac-12 Freshman of the Year.

- 11 Pac-12 student-athletes were selected AVCA All-Americans with seven of those honored being sophomore or juniors on the first or second teams. Stanford was the most represented with five All-Americans. An additional received honorable mention status. Eight different teams were represented, in all.

- Joining Stanford among the top-16-seeded teams in the NCAA Tournament were No. 8-seeded UW, No. 10-seeded USC, No. 11-seeded Utah and No. 15-seeded UCLA. Colorado, OREGON, Oregon State and WASHINGTON STATE earned bids, as well.

- The Pac-12 has won a NCAA-record 15 of 37 NCAA titles awarded.

PAC-12 IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

Pac-12 teams have compiled an impressive 457-244 (.652) record in NCAA play. Toss out the 23 post-season matches between Conference teams and the league's NCAA Tournament record against non-conference goes stands at 254-104 (.709) since 2001 and an overall mark of 390-182 (.682) ... Over the last 17 years, Pac-12 teams are 111-27 (.804) in the first round, including posting a NCAA-record 10-0 in 2015 after a NCAA record 10 league teams earned bids last year.

The Pac-12 has placed at least one Conference team in the regional semifinals in 35 of the 37 years of the tournament, missing out in 1993 and 1998. For the 18th time in the history of the postseason, the Pac-12 has had at least three teams advance to the regional final. Stanford's appearance in the national semifinal marks the 33rd time a Pac-12 team has advanced that far.

Every Pac-12 member has earned a NCAA Tournament berth since 2013 and seven different teams have reached the national semifinal all-time.

STANFORD

The third-seeded Cardinal was in the NCAA Tournament for the 37th time and first under first-year head coach Kevin Hambly, leading the team to a No. 3 seed. It is one of just two teams, along with Penn State, to never miss out on a NCAA Tournament. Stanford is the winningest all-time NCAA Tournament team, boasting a record 119 wins. It is also tied for the most NCAA titles with seven with the Nittany Lions. The Cardinal advanced to the national semifinal for the 21st time ever, falling to second-seeded Florida in five sets.

COLORADO

Second-year head coach Jesse Mahoney led the Buffs to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2014 and a the regional semifinal appearance for the first time in 20 years. Colorado knocked off 12th-seeded Baylor to advance to the regional. Colorado was in the tournament for the 19th time and has an all-time 13-19 record. In the Kentucky Regional, the Buffs were eliminated from the tournament by NCAA semifinalist Nebraska.

OREGON

The Ducks earned a NCAA Tournament for the seventh year in a row and the first time under first-year head coach Matt Ulmer. Oregon made its 15th appearance, advancing to the second round where it lost to 13th-seeded BYU. Oregon was in the NCAA final in 2012.

OREGON STATE

The Beavers were in the tournament for the fourth time in the history of the program and the second time in four years. OSU is 2-4 all-time in the event, falling to NC State in the first round.

UCLA

The No. 15-seed Bruins were in the NCAA Tournament for the 35th time in program history. Only four teams have received more NCAA Tournament invitations than the Bruins. UCLA won the NCAA title in 2011 in head coach Mike Sealy's second season. The Bruins fell to eventual NCAA semifinalist and second-ranked Florida in regional semifinal in Gainesville, Fla. UCLA has the second-most NCAA Tournament wins in the Conference (90) and second-best winning percentage in the event, as well (.738).

USC

USC made its 35th all-time appearance, boasting a 79-32 mark. The Trojans won the NCAA title in 1981, and then again in back-to-back years in 2002 and 2003. 10th-seeded USC lost to national semifinalist and second-ranked Florida in the regional final in Gainesville, Fla. The Trojans nearly knocked off the higher-ranked Gators, but fell in five sets. The Trojans have had a remarkable turnaround, finishing tied for second in the league after going just 10-10 last season and tying for seventh.

UTAH

Utah was in the NCAA Tournament for the 14th time ever, earning the No. 11 seed, its highest seeding ever and only the second time to be seeded top-16. The Utes made their first trip to the round of 16 since 2008 and their first since joining the Pac-12 in 2011. It faced sixth-seeded Texas in the regional semifinal in Stanford, Calif., in a nail-biting, five-set decision.

WASHINGTON

Washington was the No. 8 seed in the NCAA Tournament for the second-straight year and made its 22nd all-time appearance. The Huskies won the title in 2005 and advanced to the national semifinal in 2013 for the fourth time in program history. UW boasts a 48-21 all-time record. Hosting the first and second rounds as part of the Penn State regional, the Huskies were upset in the second round by Illinois in five sets.

WASHINGTON STATE

The Cougs returned to the NCAA Tournament last year for the first time since 2009 and made their 12th all-time appearance this season. It was the team's first back-to-back tournament appearance since going three years in a row from 2000-2002. The Cougs advanced to the second round of the Lexington Regional where it fell to fifth-seeded Nebraska.

CONFERENCE NOTES

• **STANFORD WINS PAC-12 TITLE ...** Stanford claimed its 17th Pac-12 crown, by far the most of any team in the Conference. It was the team's first since 2014. The Cardinal clinched the outright title on Nov. 15, sweeping USC, 3-0, at home.

• **POLL NOTES ...** The final AVCA Coaches poll of the year has six Pac-12 teams ranked with Pac-12 Champion Stanford leading the way again at No. 4. The Cardinal appeared in the top five every week this season, including topping out at No. 1 on Aug. 28.

Tied for second in the Pac-12 and advancing to the NCAA Regional final, USC ends the season at No. 7 after starting the season unranked. UTAH receives its highest final ranking in program history at No. 11, UCLA is No. 14, WASHINGTON is No. 15 and COLORADO is No. 19.

• **UPSETS MOUNT ...** With so many upsets this season, could it really be called an "upset" anymore? There were 29 upsets (based on the weekly AVCA poll) by Pac-12 teams this season, 21 coming in league matches. USC accounted for the most with seven, four against league opponents. Colorado knocked off six ranked opponents, four in Pac-12 play. Oregon upset five higher-ranked opponents (three in league matchups). Ten Pac-12 teams recorded at least one upset the last recorded with the Trojans knocking off seventh-seeded Minnesota to advance to the regional final in Gainesville, Fla.

• **AVCA ALL-AMERICA HONORS ...** Eleven from the Pac-12 were named AVCA All-Americans, marking the ninth time in 12 seasons the Conference has had at least 10 All-Americans. STANFORD was the most represented with five players honored. Sophomores Jenna Gray, Kathryn Plummer and Morgan Hentz were named to the first team. Teammates Audiranna Fitzmorris, also a sophomore, and senior Merete Lutz were voted to the second team. Lutz earns All-America nods for the third time in her career. UTAH's Adora Anae closed out her career with her second All-American nod, earning a spot on the first team, while USC's Khalia Lanier earns her first All-America recognition. UCLA's Madeleine Gates and COLORADO's Alexa Smith were second team honorees. Fellow Trojan Brittany Abercrombie and WASHINGTON's Carly DeHoog were on the third team. Another 10 from the Conference received honorable mention status: OREGON's Taylor Agost, Stanford's Tami Alade, Colorado's Brynna Deluzio, Utah's Tawnee Luafalemana and Berkeley Oblad, OREGON STATE's Mary-Kate Marshall, UCLA's Zana Munro and Sarah Sponcil, and UW's Tia Scambray,

• **AVCA REGION HONORS ...** A combined 16 Pac-12 players earned AVCA All-Pacific North and Pacific South honors. Regional Players of the Year were also announced with STANFORD's Kathryn Plummer garnering the Pacific North accolade and UTAH's Adora Anae receiving the Pacific South nod. OREGON STATE's Kylee McLaughlin and COLORADO's Brynna Deluzio were selected the Pacific North and Pacific South Freshmen of the Year, respectively.

Plummer was voted the Pac-12 Player of the Year, leading the Cardinal to a 17th league crown and a No. 3 seeding in the NCAA Tournament. The defending NCAA Champion are headed to its 21st national semifinal.

Anae is a three-time Pac-12 honoree leading the Utes to a No. 11 NCAA Tournament seeding, the program's highest ever. McLaughlin (10.69) and Deluzio (11.10) are two of the Pac-12's top setters, ranking fourth and third, respectively, in assists per set. Both led their teams back to the NCAA Tournament.

Nine of the 14 players on the All-Pacific North team are from the Pac-12, including five from Stanford. The Cardinal's redshirt senior Merete Lutz earns a spot on the team for the fourth time and sophomore teammate Plummer is on the team for the second year in a row.

Joining them on the Pacific North team are Stanford middle blocker Audiranna Fitzmorris, setter Jenna Gray and libero Morgan Hentz, all of which are sophomores; WASHINGTON seniors Carly DeHoog, Tia Scambray and Courtney Schwan. Schwan is on the team for the second time. OREGON STATE senior Mary-Kate Marshall is also on the list, earning a third-straight honor.

OREGON's Taylor Agost and Ronika Stone, Stanford's Tami Alade, and UW's Bailey Tanner were honorable mention.

The Pacific South team includes seven players from the Pac-12. Teammate Tawnee Luafalemana joins Anae on the team. From USC, senior Brittany Abercrombie and sophomore Khalia Lanier earn a spot, with Lanier receiving her second-straight nod. UCLA also had a pair of selections with sophomore Madeleine Gates and senior Sarah Sponcil. Sponcil earned the recognition for the third time. Colorado junior Alexa Smith was also named to the team.

On the Pacific South honorable mention team are UCLA's Reily Buechler and Zana Munro, the Buffs' Brynna Deluzio, and Utah's Berkeley Oblad.

• **AROUND THE LEAGUE ...** CALIFORNIA had more overall wins and league wins than each of the last three seasons. With 13 overall wins, the Bears reached double-digit wins for the first time since 2014 ... COLORADO records its first 20-win season since 2014 and its 21 wins are the most since setting the program record of 26 in 1993. Its 11 conference wins are the most since joining the Pac-12 in 2011 and are almost double its total from last year (6) ... OREGON STATE closed the book on one of its best seasons. Its 11 wins tied for the program record set in 1990 and it was only the second time OSU had recorded double-digit conference victories. Its 21 wins are just the third time since the Pac-12 started sponsoring the sport that it has had a 20-win campaign ... STANFORD picked up its 10th Pac-12 win of the season, marking the 32nd season the Cardinal has won double-digit league matches. The Cardinal has also won at least 13 league wins every year since the Pac-12/10 became sponsoring women's athletics (dating back to 1986). It has also had a 20-win campaign every year since 2000 ... UCLA has recorded a 20-win season in each of the last four seasons and in 18 of the last 19 seasons ... USC posted its 20 win campaign, making it more wins than all of last season (18). The Trojans have also won more league games than last year (10) ... UTAH has recorded back-to-back 20-win campaigns for the first time since joining the Pac-12. Its 12 Pac-12 wins are a team record, also marking just the second time the Utes have recorded double-digit league wins since joining the Pac-12 ... WASHINGTON has had a 20-win campaign every season since 2002. Only Stanford has had a longer streak ... WASHINGTON STATE's back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances are its first since 2000 and 2001.

• **NCAA ACTIVE LEADERS ...** The Conference's active career leader in kills, UTAH's Adora Anae ranks fourth among active Division I players with 1,920 kills. It also ties her for 10th all-time in Pac-12 history. Just behind her in the NCAA is OREGON STATE's Mary-Kate Marshall, whose 1,915 kills rank fifth among

ALL-PAC-12 HONORS

PLAYER OF THE YEAR - KATHRYN PLUMMER, OH, STANFORD

A year after being voted the Pac-12 Freshman of the Year and AVCA National Freshman of the Year, sophomore Kathryn Plummer was voted the Pac-12 Player of the Year by the league's coaches. It is the 15th time a Cardinal has earned the Conference's top honor and first since 2010. She is also just the second player in Conference history, and first in 27 years, to be named the league's player of the year a season after being selected the freshman of the year. The last time that occurred was when former Cardinal Bev Oden was tabbed the freshman of the year in 1989 then followed up with a player-of-the-year outing in 1990.

An All-Pac-12 honoree for the second-straight year, Plummer has led the Cardinal to its 17th Pac-12 crown with a 19-1 league record and a No. 3 overall seed in the NCAA Tournament. She leads the Conference with 4.70 kills per set and 5.43 points per set, ranking ninth and sixth, respectively, in the NCAA in each category. She was twice voted the Pac-12 Offensive Player of the Week and selected the ESPNW National Player of the Week on Nov. 2.

FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR - KYLEE MCLAUGHLIN, S, OREGON STATE

Kylee McLughlin is the second Beaver all-time, and second since teammate Mary-Kate Marshall was voted in 2014, to be picked the Pac-12 Freshman of the Year. McLaughlin has helped OSU finish in a tie for seventh in the Pac-12 and post 11 league wins, tying a program record set in 1990. She has also guided the team to its third 20-win season and second in three years. McLaughlin is fourth in the Pac-12 in assists per set, doling out an average of 10.72. She was voted the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week three times this season.

COACH OF THE YEAR - MARK BARNARD, OREGON STATE

Mark Barnard is the second coach at Oregon State to win the Pac-12 Coach of the Year honor in four years and just the third all-time. He follows former head coach Taras Liskevych, whom Barnard was a long time assistant under, getting the nod in 2014 and Guy Enriques was the co-coach of the year in 1990. Barnard has led the Beavers to a nine-match turnaround from last season, posting a 21-11 overall record, the program's second 20-win campaign in four years and just the third since the Pac-12 began sponsoring volleyball in 1986. The Beavers are getting set to make their fourth NCAA Tournament appearance all-time after posting a team-record tying 11 league record, a six-match improvement from a season ago. In just his second season at the helm, Barnard has led the OSU to historic moments this season: it posted its first sweep through the state of Washington since 1990; it was also claimed its first win over Washington since 2001; it defeated both Arizona schools at home, the first time it had done that since 1996; its five-match win streak from Oct. 13-27, was its longest in league play since 1990. Additionally, the desert schools were on the wrong side of another significant streak buster when the Beavs swept the Arizona schools for the complete season-sweep since 1990 also finished a season-sweep of the Washington schools for the first time in Pac-12 history and since 1984. This season, Barnard's student-athletes have claimed the Pac-12 Offensive Player of the Week honor three times, Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Week twice, and Pac-12 Freshman of the Week four times. It is the most the Beavers have been cited for weekly honors in a season in the history of the program.

SETTER OF THE YEAR - JENNA GRAY, SO, STANFORD

A Cardinal is tabbed the Pac-12 Setter of the Year for the fourth time in the seven-year history of the award. Sophomore Jenna Gray has directed the Stanford offense in its title-winning season, averaging 12.12 assists per set which is tops in the Pac-12 and third-best in the nation. With Gray leading the charge, the Cardinal offense is the most efficient in the Pac-12, boasting a .312 hitting percentage which also ranks seventh in the NCAA. Stanford also ranks 14th in the country with a 14.39 kills per set average and as a team, it ranks 16th in assists per set (13.50). Gray is the second sophomore to win the setter honor after former Cardinal won the award in 2013 for the first of three-consecutive years.

LIBERO OF THE YEAR - MORGAN HENTZ, SO, STANFORD

Morgan Hentz is the second sophomore in the six-year history of the award to earn the honor, USC's Natalie Hagglund who won the award from 2011-13. Hentz became the 18th player in Stanford history to record 1,000 wins on Nov. 16 after setting a program rookie record with 630 total digs last season. Her defensive ability has limited opposing offense to just .177 hitting as opponents alter their attack because of her digging prowess. The Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Week on Oct. 23, she was named to the Preseason All-Pac-12 team. She has helped the Cardinal claim its 17th all-time Pac-12 crown and a No. 3 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

• **WHAT'S BACK ...** Seven AVCA All-Americans returned from last year, including 2016 Pac-12 Player of the Year Courtney Schwan and AVCA National Freshman of the Year Kathryn Plummer. UW has three 2016 All-Americans on its current roster, while Stanford has two. Senior Adora Anae is also back for the Utes this year, as is Ducks junior Lindsey Vander Weide.

• Eight of the 14 players named to the 2016 All-Pac-12 team return for 2017, including UW's Schwan, who was tabbed the 2016 Pac-12 Player of the Year. Stanford's Plummer was voted the 2016 Pac-12 Freshman of the Year and looks to build upon an impressive rookie campaign.

• **FAB FRESHMAN ...** Pac-12 volleyball continues to attract marquee student-athletes. Eight Pac-12 teams landed at least one Volleyball Magazine FAB 50 recruit with UCLA pacing the league with four.

• **NEW COACHES ...** The Pac-12 welcomes four new coaches to the Conference this season. Sanja Toma-sevic takes over the helm at ARIZONA STATE; Matt Ulmer roams the sidelines as head coach in Eugene; while Kevin Hambly takes over a Stanford program that is defending its national crown. Half the Pac-12 teams have put new coaches in place over the last two years, three due to retirement of long-time head coaches. Seven in total have coaches that have been at the helm for three years or less in the Pac-12.

HISTORICALLY SPEAKING

• The Pac-12 has captured seven of the last 17 NCAA crowns (2016 - Stanford, 2011 - UCLA, 2005 - Washington, 2004 - Stanford, 2003 - USC, 2002 - USC, 2001 - Stanford) and a record 15 NCAA titles overall.

• Pac-12 coaches have led NCAA Division I teams to 40 NCAA semifinal appearances and eight NCAA titles. In the last 16 years, seven different coaches have been named the ASICS/Volleyball Magazine Coach of the Year and/or the AVCA Coach of the Year.

• The Pac-12 has had 10 or more All-Americans selections in nine of the last 12 years. Eleven former Pac-12 players have earned All-America honors four times, while 20 players in all have earned All-American honors three times.

• Since 1990, Pac-12 players garnered AVCA Player of the Year honors 15 times, including the six of the last eight - CAL's Carli Lloyd (2010), USC's Alex Jupiter (2011), ORE's Alaina Bergsma (2012), WASH's Krista Vansant (2013), USC's Samantha Bricio (2015) and the latest honoree STAN's Kathryn Plummer (2017). The NCAA Honda Sports Award honor has been bestowed upon a Pac-12 volleyball player 14 times, including Stanford's Inky Ajanaku in 2016.

WASHINGTON VOTED 2017 PAC-12 PRESEASON FAVORITE

SAN FRANCISCO -- The 12 league women's volleyball coaches voted defending Pac-12 champion WASHINGTON the pre-season favorite, the Conference office announced on Wednesday. The Huskies received eight first-place votes and collected 118 points to edge defending NCAA Champion STANFORD, which posted 113 points and three first-place votes. OREGON was third in the poll with 93 points.

In addition to the annual coaches poll, the Pac-12 announced the Preseason All-Pac-12 team, as voted on by the league coaches. Nine of the 14 all-Conference honorees from a year ago appear on the 14-player preseason squad, including the 2016 Pac-12 Player of the Year UW's Courtney Schwan and last year's Pac-12 Freshman of the Year Kathryn Plummer of Stanford.

The Huskies have won back-to-back Pac-12 crowns and look to make it three in a row with a corps of three senior 2016 All-Pac-12 honorees, including Schwan. All three were also named All-Americans last year after leading UW to a 29-5 overall record and 16-4 league mark.

The Cardinal has a pair of All-Americans in Plummer and senior Merete Lutz but are under the direction of a new head coach for the first time in 17 years when Hall of Fame coach John Dunning retired after winning the national title. Kevin Hambly, who found success at Illinois, takes over the helm at Stanford.

The Ducks are also under the direction of a new head coach as Matt Ulmer takes over for 2017, with two 2017 All-Pac-12 picks on the roster. In fourth with 88 points is UTAH, which garnered one first-place vote. All-American Adora Anae, who was top 10 in the nation in kills per set and total points last year, returns to lead the Utes.

Rounding out the top half of the coaches poll are UCLA, which received 88 points and USC, which collected 83 points. Senior Reily Buechler helped the Bruins advance to the NCAA quarterfinal last season and the Trojans welcome back Khalia Lanier who was an All-Pac-12 pick as a freshman last season.

WASHINGTON STATE posted 71 points and look to build on its first NCAA Tournament appearance last year since 2009. Voted eighth with 51 points, ARIZONA and head coach Dave Rubio has one of the best recruiting programs in recent history entering the school year. COLORADO is ninth in the polling with 38 points as the Buffs enter year two under head coach Jesse Mahoney, while OREGON STATE was tabbed 10th with 33 points. The Beavers also have a second-year head coach in Mark Barnard.

CALIFORNIA (23 points) and ARIZONA STATE (15 points) were picked to finish 11th and 12th in the coaches poll. Both look to new head coaches at the helm Matt McShane taking over the bench after 18-year head coach Rich Feller retired, while ASU has rookie-head coach Sonja Tomasevic taking over in 2017.

PAC-12 IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

The Pac-12 has won a NCAA-record 15 of 37 NCAA titles awarded with Stanford winning its record-tying seventh crown in 2017. UCLA claimed the NCAA title in 2011, while Washington was the national champion in 2005, Stanford in 2001 and 2004, and USC was the winner in 2002 and 2003 ... Pac-12 teams have compiled an impressive 457-244 (.652) record in NCAA play. Toss out the 23 postseason matches between Conference teams and the league's NCAA Tournament record against non-conference goes stands at 254-104 (.709) since 2001 and an overall mark of 390-182 (.682) ... Over the last 17 years, Pac-12 teams are 111-27 (.804) in the first round, including posting a NCAA-record 10-0 in 2015 after a NCAA record 10 league teams earned bids last year. It is the 17th-consecutive year the Conference has had at least six teams earn NCAA Tournament bids. Below is the current won-loss records of Pac-12 members in NCAA play:
