PAC-12 TEAMS BEGIN TO JOCKEY FOR TOURNAMENT SEEDINGS

Pac-12 women's basketball teams are passed the mid-point of the Conference season and with the Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament just a month away, wins and losses begin to take on more weight. Additionally, teams in NCAA Tournament contention are looking to finish strong and nab one of the higher seeds, while teams on the bubble have four more weeks to improve their resume ... Rivalry matchups set for this week are between ARIZONA and No. 11/16 ARIZONA STATE, while UCLA and USC wrap up its series this week ... The Sun Devils' No. 11 Associated Press ranking this week is their highest since being ranked No. 10 in the final poll of the 2006-07 season. They are also ranked No. 16 in the USA Today/WBCA Coaches poll. Also ranked this week is STANFORD, who rises to No. 3 for the marking the highest ranking since the first couple of weeks of the season. CALIFORNIA is at No. 23/22, making it 34 consecutive-weeks the Golden Bears have been in the polls ... Stanford's Chiney Ogwumike was named the Pac-12 Player of the Week for a Conference-record seventh time this season. She continues to have a stellar campaign as she wraps up her collegiate career, averaging 27.1 points per game and 12.0 rebounds per game, which rank third and ninth, respectively, in the country. Her 63.3 percent shooting accuracy is second-best in the nation, as well. OREGON's Chrisae Rowe was the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week for a league-record sixth time this season. Rowe continues to be the top-scoring freshman in the country, averaging 22.3 ppg for the Ducks, who continue to boast the best scoring average in the country at 95.3 ... Speaking of the Ducks, Rowe's teammate, Jillian Alleyne, is the nation's rebounding leader at 15.5 rpg ... Eight games are slated to be televised on the Pac-12 Networks this week, with th Wildcats visiting the Sun Devils on Tuesday night to kick off the week. Stanford will visit Washington on Sunday for a game that will be broadcast on ESPNU.

The 13th-annual Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament heads to Seattle again, in partnership with Force 10 Sports Marketing, LLC, the Seattle Sports Commission and Seattle Center. The tournament will be played at KeyArena from March 6-9, 2014 and will also receive unprecedented national television coverage of the women's basketball teams and players as every game of the tournament will be televised either on the Pac-12 Networks or ESPN2. The new agreement, which began in 2013, runs through the 2015 tournament.

The Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament made its debut in 2002 and was held on the University of Oregon campus in Eugene, Ore. The Conference's premier women's sporting event then moved to HP Pavilion at San Jose for a six-year run (2003-08). It spent four years (2008-2012) in Los Angeles, with Galen Center playing host. The final two-year run of the event saw it combined with the men's tournament and the semifinal and championship games were played at the STAPLES Center.

The winner of the 12-team tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. The tournament seeding and Conference Champion are determined by the 18-game regular-season Pac-12 schedule.

A league-record 100+ appearances during the regular season, including 101 telecasts on the Pac-12 Networks and five on the ESPN networks as part of the Conference's television package. Among those 106 appearances, all 11 games of the Pac-12 Tournament at KeyArena in Seattle will be televised, with nine appearing on the Pac-12 Networks and the championship game on ESPN on March 9. The Pac-12 Networks launched in the summer of 2012 with one national and six regional networks devoted solely to Pac-12 sports. In addition to the hundreds of live televised Pac-12 sporting events, subscribers can watch live events on the Pac-12 Now app and on-demand content on the web at pac-12.com.

PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. - The Pac-12 Conference office announced today the Pac-12 Women's Basketball Players of the Week for the week of Jan. 27-Feb. 2. Earning the honor for a Conference-record seventh time this season, STANFORD's Chiney Ogumike was voted Pac-12 Player of the Week, while OREGON's Chrishae Rowe is named the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week for the second-straight week and a league-record sixth time.

Senior forward Chiney Ogumike (Cypress, Texas) receives the weekly nod for the seventh time this season after leading third-ranked Stanford to a win over USC and a sweep of then-No. 21/19 California last week, averaging 27.3 points and 10.7 rebounds while shooting 58.9 percent from the field. She breaks the league mark for most weekly awards she set last year with six. The week started Monday with 30 points and 12 rebounds in an 86-59 win over USC, and continued Thursday at Maples Pavilion when she scored 23 points with 12 rebounds in the Cardinal's 70-64 victory. Three days later, she went for 29 points with eight rebounds, four assists and three blocks. With the victories, Stanford extends its winning streak to 20 games.

Guard Chrishae Rowe (Corona, Calif.) helped the Ducks to an 84-72 win at Arizona, then nearly upset No. 11 Arizona State, 97-94. She scored 24 points and led the team with three steals and three 3-pointers in the win over the Wildcats. She then had 39 points at ASU, just two points shy of her own school record, also going 13-of-14 from the free throw line against the Sun Devils. The highest-scoring freshman in the nation, Rowe ranks second in the Pac-12 in scoring, averaging 22.3 points per game. Her sixth-weekly freshman recognition breaks the Pac-12's single-season record set last year by COLORADO's Arielle Roberson, who earned the honor five times in the inaugural year of the award.

It is Ogumike's Pac-12 record 16th-career weekly honor and Stanford's 97th all-time.

A player of the week has been selected every week since 1986-87, the first year the Conference sponsored women's sports. A freshman of the week was first selected in 2012-13.

CONFERENCE SEASON NOTES

TEAMS SEE IMPROVEMENT: The 2013-14 editions of several Pac-12 teams have seen major improvements so far this season. Arizona State, Oregon, Oregon State, Washington State and USC have all surpassed its win totals from a year ago. ASU's 19 wins so far this season are the most since 2008-09.

Meanwhile, in Conference play, ASU, Oregon and Oregon State have more wins already, while the Trojans and Cougars have matched last year's league totals.

RECORDS FALL IN THE EARLY SEASON: It did not take long for Pac-12 teams to make 2013-14 a memorable campaign. In just the first weekend, OREGON took down a pair of Pac-12 records. The Ducks scored an incredible 131 points against CS Bakserfield on Nov. 9, shattering the Pac-12 single-game mark set 20 years ago. UO also netted a league-record 20 threes in the game.

STANFORD's Chiney Ogwumike became the Pac-12's leading rebounder in the team's Pac-12 opener. Earlier in the season, she broke the league record for most-career weekly honors and now has 13 in her career.

Among the significant milestones achieved this season is Hall of Fame Stanford head coach Tara VanDerveer winning her 900th-career game.

DUCKS BREAK MORE RECORDS: OREGON already rewrote the Pac-12's single-game scoring record, tallying 131 points in a win on Nov. 9. But the Ducks decided to rewrite an NCAA record, as well. UO combined with Sacramento State to attempt 182 three-point field goals in the loss to the Hornets. The 182 long-range attempts broke a collegiate record that was set in 1999. The combined 86 three-point made buckets also broke a UO record.

MIDSEASON RECOGNITION: Stanford's Chiney Ogwumike and California's Brittany Boyd made the cut for midseason candidates for the John R. Wooden Award, which was announced last week. Also announced last week were the candidates for the Nancy Lieberman Award, presented to the top-collegiate point guard in the country. Stanford's Amber Orrange earned the early nod, as did Boyd.

VANDERVEER JOINS 900 CLUB: STANFORD's Tara VanDerveer won her 900th career game on Nov. 27 becoming just the fifth women's coach in NCAA history to reach the milestone. VanDerveer is in her 35th season as a head coach and 28th at the Stanford helm. She joins Pat Summitt, Jody Conradt, C. Vivian Stringer and Sylvia Hatchell in the exclusive club.

ALL-STAR RETURNS: All signs indicate another competitive season as eight of the 15 members of the 2013 All-Pac-12 team return for the 2013-14. Also among the returnees are nine of the 11 players named honorable mention all-conference.

Among the all-star returnees is 2013 Pac-12 Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year F Chiney Ogwumike of Stanford, who is in her final season in Palo Alto. Three members of the all-defensive squad are back, including Ogwumike, JR F Aminah Williams of WASHINGTON and SR G Brittany Wilson of COLORADO.

OFFENSIVE RETURNS: Eight of the Conference teams return its leading scorer from a year ago eight also welcome back its top rebounder, including the Pac-12's leading scorer and rebounder in SR F Chiney Ogwumike of Stanford.

Last year, the Pac-12 had five of the nation's top 25 rebounders and they are all back this season (stats are final from the 2012-13 season): Ogwumike (12.9), Oregon's Jillian Alleyne (11.9), California's Jennifer Brandon (11.1), Washington's Aminah Williams (10.8) and Utah's Michelle Plouffe (9.4).

NEW FACES & FAMILIAR FACES: Heading into the 2013-14 campaign, the Conference welcomes two new head coaches in Cynthia Cooper at USC and Washington's Mike Neighbors. Each brings an impressive resume finding success at several stops in Division I women's basketball.

The Pac-12 has a mix of veteran and young coaches. Leading the way is 10-time John R. Wooden Pac-12 Coach of the Year Tara VanDerveer who embarks on her 28th year at Stanford and 35th overall. Pac-12 coaches average 6.1 years of experience in the Pac-12 and 9.3 years overall in collegiate basketball heading into the 2013-14 campaign.

ROAD TO NASHVILLE GOES THROUGH THE PAC-12: For teams looking to get to Nashville for the NCAA Women's Final Four, they may have to go through Pac-12 country.

Two league schools were selected as first- and second-round sites for the 2014 NCAA Women's Basketball Tournament. UCLA's Pauley Pavilion was picked to host on March 22 and 24, while Washington's Alaska Airlines Arena was selected to host on March 23 and 25. If the Huskies and Bruins were to earn a NCAA bid, they would play on their home court.

Stanford's Maples Pavilion was also selected to host the NCAA Regional semifinals and finals on March 29 and April 1. If the Cardinal should earn a NCAA Tournament bid and advance to the regional semifinals, it would play on its home court.

The Final Four is slated to be held on April 6 and 8 at the Bridgestone Arena in Nashville, Tenn.

POINT MARGINS IN WINS-LOSSES

TEAM NOTES

ARIZONA (4-17, 0-10)

UA has come close to snapping its lengthy losing skid, now at ten games. Ten of its losses have been by 10 points or less, including five of its seven Pac-12 setbacks, including a 60-57 loss to Utah ... RS JR guard Candice Warthen is back for the Wildcats this season after sitting out all of last season due to injury. It is a welcome return as she leads the Wildcats in scoring (12.0) and steals (1.2) ... However, UA has been without SR F Alli Gloyd because of a season-ending injury suffered at the start of the 2013-14 campaign. She was one of only two Wildcats to start every game last year ... Arizona closed the non-conference season with three-straight victories, defeating Texas Tech, 65-56, on Dec. 15 to jump start the win streak.

ARIZONA STATE (19-3, 8-2)

After starting the season unranked, the Sun Devils made their way up to No. 11 this week in the *Associated Press* poll, their highest ranking since Dec. 21, 2009 ... ASU already has more wins and more Pac-12 wins than all of last season ... ASU's 11-1 start to the season was the team's best since 1986-87, including wins over ranked teams - No. 11 North Carolina and No. 20 Syracuse ... ASU has vastly improved its scoring this season, averaging 16.4 ppg better than a year ago. Among the team's reasons for the improvement is the team's shooting percentage. The Sun Devils shot just 38.6 percent last year and are shooting at a 43.9 percent clip ... ASU's success can also be attributed to its balanced scoring, as four players are averaging at least 8.0 ppg. RS-SR G Deja Mann leads the way with 11.5 ppg after missing all of last season because of injury ... 12 of ASU's wins have come when it was either trailing or ahead by only one point at some point in the last five minutes of regulation.

CALIFORNIA (14-7, 6-4)

The Golden Bears have been ranked all season and five of their seven losses have been to ranked opponents, including most recently two-straight to then No. 4 Stanford and earlier in the season two losses against opponents ranked in the top three at the time of the meeting ... After playing in just the first two games of the season (for a total of 34 minutes), Cal welcomed back national player of the year candidate Gennifer Brandon, who scored her 1,000th-career point in an overtime win over Oregon ... In Brandon's absence, JR F Reshanda Gray has been a tremendous force for the Bears, averaging a team-best 16.0 ppg and 7.6 rpg, more than double her scoring average from last year and over 2.0 rpg better than last year. She has also been a starter in every game this season, compared to just one game last year. She's been playing even better since league play began, averaging 16.4 ppg and 8.7 rpg ... JR G Brittany Boyd is leading the Pac-12 with 5.5 apg and 3.1 steals per game, while scoring 14.8 ppg.

COLORADO (13-8, 3-7)

Colorado reeled off nine wins in a row to start the season, but all eight of their losses have come in the last 12 games, three of which were to top-25 foes, including Louisville and Stanford, who are both ranked in the top five ... Colorado is without starting guard Jasmine Sborov, who was injured in the two-point loss to California on Jan. 10. She is expected to be out for a few more weeks ... The Buffs have three players averaging double-digit scoring with Jen Reese leading the way at 12.5 ppg. 2013 Pac-12 Freshman of the Year Arielle Roberson is second in scoring (12.8 ppg), while leading the team in rebounding average (7.8 rpg) ... After snapping a four-game skid with a 68-47 win over Arizona, the Buffs lost a couple of single-digit games, a two-point decision to then-No. 14 ASU and a three-point loss to Utah, but got back on the winning

track with in the rivalry rematch 61-45 at home.

OREGON (12-9, 3-7)

The Ducks lead the nation in scoring at 95.3 points per game, picking up Conference wins over Washington, Washington State and Arizona and falling just short of an upset bid over No. 15 Arizona State ... UO has tripled its win total from a year ago ... Oregon has improved its scoring by nearly 35.0 ppg from last year, reaching triple digits eight times and tallying at least 90 points 11 times ... UO opened 2013-14 scoring 131 points to shatter the Pac-12 single-game scoring mark ... FR G Chrishae Rowe is the top-scoring freshman in the country, tying for the team lead and ranking 14th in the nation at 22.3 ppg. She scored a Pac-12 season-high 41 points in a win on Dec. 4 ... SO F Jillian Alleyne leads NCAA Division I in rebounding, averaging 15.5 rpg, after collecting 25 in a win over Washington. She is also the country's double-doubles leader at 19 ... Rowe was named Freshman of the Week for the second-consecutive week and a record sixth time overall this season.

OREGON STATE (13-9, 5-5)

The Beavers split at the Arizona schools over the weekend to keep their league mark at .500. OSU has surpassed both its Pac-12 win total and overall season total from a year ago ... OSU has posted six wins of 10-points or less, with three of those coming by five or less points ... OSU ranks eighth in the country in blocks (5.9 bpg), led by Ruth Hamblin's 3.45 bpg, which ranks fifth in the nation. She recorded a school-record nine blocks against No. 2 Notre Dame. She also recorded the 17th triple-double in Pac-12/10 history in the home win over the Ducks and is the first-ever to accomplish the feat with 10 blocks ... OSU has turned up the offensive pressure this year, averaging 73.1 ppg as compared to 57.3 ppg a season ago. But continues to maintain a strong defensive stance, limiting opponents to just 36.2 field goal percentage, which ranks third in the Pac-12 ... SO G Jamie Weisner is building on a stellar freshman campaign, leading the team in scoring again at 13.8 ppg. She is receiving help from freshman Sydney Weise, who is netting 13.1 ppg.

STANFORD (19-1, 8-0)

The Cardinal is ranked No. 3 in the country this week, the highest of the season, and is riding a 20-game win streak. Its only loss of the season was to defending NCAA Champion Connecticut ... Among the wins during the streak is a victory over then-top five, perennial power Tennessee, handing the Lady Vols their first loss of the season ... Stanford is again looking to an Ogwumike to lead the team, as the younger sister is in the midst of her final campaign. The All-American is leading the Pac-12 in scoring (27.0), also ranking third in the country. Her 12.0 rpg are ninth in the nation and she is second in the country in field goal percentage at 63.3. Ogwumike became the Pac-12's all-time leading rebounder ... Hall of fame head coach Tara VanDerveer posted her 900th-career victory earlier this season, becoming only the fifth women's basketball coach in NCAA women's basketball history to reach the threshold ... Ogwumike was named to the Wooden Award midseason watch list, while JR G Amber Orrange was named to the Nancy Lieberman Award watch list.

UCLA (11-12, 5-6)

UCLA snapped a three-game losing streak, defeating Washington State at home ... Eight of UCLA's Conference games have been decided by six points or less ... UCLA has had to contend with a slim roster because of injuries, but have been more than competitive, with six of its setbacks coming by 10 points or less. Despite the slim roster, the Bruins posted a notable win over Oklahoma, who was ranked No. 10 at the time of the meeting ... SO G Nirra Fields and

SR F Atonye Nyingifa have been trading the scoring lead, with Nyingifa leading the team in scoring this week at 18.0 ppg, while Fields is averaging 17.2 ppg. Nyingifa is the team's rebounding leader at 9.0, grabbing 9.7 rpg in Pac-12 play.

USC (14-9, 7-4)

USC already has three more wins compared to last season and has equaled its league win total from a year ago, as well ... The Trojans posted an upset of then-No. 12 Colorado for their first win over a ranked opponent since 2011 and also had a big upset at No. 23/22 California ... USC has lost its last three games, including a setback at No. 3/3 Stanford. Three of the team's four league losses have been by 10 points or less ... USC opened the 2013-14 with a 3-0 start, the team's best since 1998-99 ... USC is under the direction of first-year head coach, legendary basketball player and USC alumni Cynthia Cooper ... JR G Ariya Crook and SR F Cassie Harberts are the team's scoring leaders, averaging 16.0 and 16.3 ppg, respectively, while Harberts is grabbing a team-best 7.7 rpg, including 8.4 rpg in Pac-12 play.

UTAH (10-11, 3-7)

The Utes have won three of their last five, splitting the rivalry series with Colorado ... Five of the team's last six games have been decided by three points or less, including an overtime loss ... Utah went undefeated in the month of December, which included a double-overtime win over BYU in Provo ... All-Pac-12 performer Taryn Wicijowski is out for the season because of an injury ... Two of the five games during the December stretch were without All-Pac-12 performer and the team's leading scorer and rebounder Michelle Plouffe. Plouffe is tallying 17.4 ppg and 10.1 rpg. ... FR F Emily Potter is one of two players scoring in double figures, contributing 11.3 ppg and is the team's second-leading rebounder at 6.8 rpg.

WASHINGTON (12-9, 5-5)

The Huskies won back-to-back games in Los Angeles, bringing their Pac-12 record to .500, while winning four of their last six games ... One of its Pac-12 wins was an upset of then-No. 20/21 Colorado for the team's first win over a ranked opponent this season ... UW has three players averaging double digits with FR G Kelsey Plum leading the way with 19.8 ppg, followed by JR PG Jazmine Davis at 19.4 points per game - both in the top five in the Pac-12. Both have been even better in Pac-12 games, averaging 21.4 ppg and 20.1 ppg, respectively ... Plum is the second-highest scoring freshman in the country, behind Oregon's Chrishae Rowe ... Washington is under the direction of first-time head coach Mike Neighbors who was an assistant coach last season.

WASHINGTON STATE (12-10, 6-4)

The Cougs have hit a rough patch, losing four of their last five after opening the Pac-12 slate with a 5-0 record. One of the reason for the skid is injuries. WSU's 59-57 loss to Utah was without second-leading scorer SO G Lia Galdeira (18.0 ppg). The loss to the Utes started a three-game losing streak, before Washington State ended it with a four-point victory at USC. The Cougs, however, then lost at UCLA ... WSU's 12 wins surpasses all of last year's total, while the six Pac-12 victories equals last year's effort ... WSU posted signature wins over then-No. 10 Nebraska and then-top-25 foes Arizona State and Colorado at home ... The Cougs' 5-0 start was their first-ever in Pac-10/12 history ... WSU's 82-80 win over the Huskies on January 7 was its first since 1995, snapping a 36-game losing streak to UW. The Cougs then their first win in Seattle since 1993 later that week ... WSU has shown significant improvement in its scoring, averaging 72.5 ppg. Washington State averaged just 59.4 ppg all season last year.
